children killed by a rocket fell on the occupied Syrian town of Majdal Shams

The Syrian Human Rights Committee (SHRC) documented the killing of 80 people in Syria during the month of July 2024, including 22 children, 3 women, and 1 person who died under torture.

In the occupied Syrian town of Majdal Shams in Quneitra province, 12 children were killed by a rocket that fell on a playground where they were playing. The occupation forces and Hezbollah accused each other of launching the rocket, while the Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) were responsible for the killing of 6 people, the Assad regime for the killing of 4 people, ISIS for the killing of 2 people, and the Turkish gendarmerie for the killing of 1 person.

SHRC also documented the assassination of 46 people by unknown assailants, 5 people due to the explosion of remnants of bombardment and improvised explosive devices, and 4 people due to the explosion of landmines.

Daraa province topped the list of other provinces in terms of the number of victims with 29 people, followed by the provinces of Raqqa and Quneitra with 12 people each, and then Aleppo province

with 10 people.

The total number of victims in Deir ez-Zor province was 5 people, 4 people in Rif Dimashq province, 3 people in Hasakah province, 2 in each of Idlib and Homs provinces, and 1 in the capital, Damascus.
