Report for May 2024 on the Number of Human Rights Violations Victims in Syria

The Syrian Human Rights Committee (SHRC) documented the killing of 58 people in Syria during May 2024. Among them were 12 children, 3 women, and 4 individuals who were killed under torture.

Forces of the Assad regime were responsible for the killing of 9 people, while the Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) were responsible for the killing of 9 people. Opposition factions were responsible for the killing of one person.

SHRC documented the assassination of 29 people by unknown assailants. Additionally, 7 people were documented to have been killed due to the explosion of explosive devices and remnants of shelling, and 3 were killed by landmines.

Daraa province topped the list of other provinces in terms of the number of victims, with 26 peopl It was followed by Aleppo province with 12 people, and then Deir ez-Zor province with 10 people.

The total number of victims in Al-Hasakah province was 4 people, 2 in both the capital Damascus and Al-Hasakah province, and one in each of the provinces of Idlib, Homs, and Ragga.
