WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

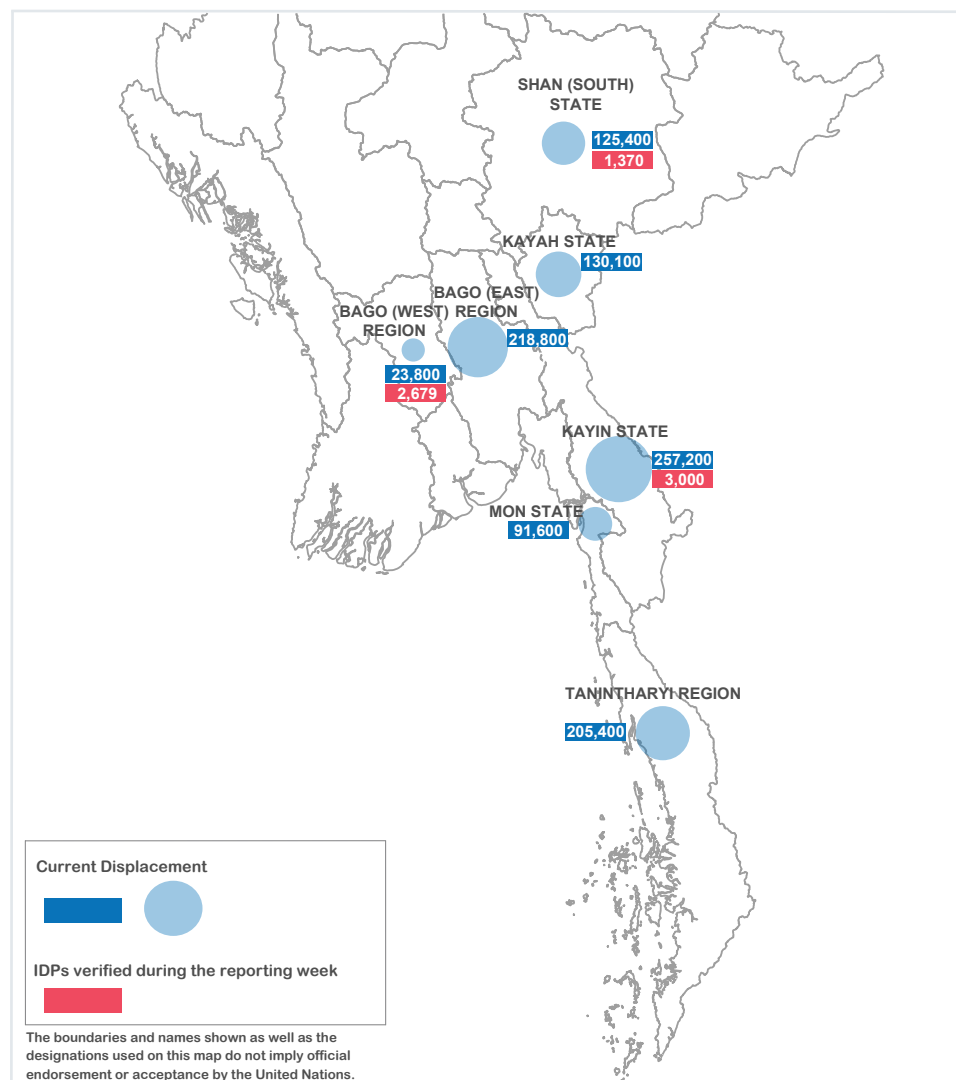
In the South-East, the number of IDPs increased from 1,046,300 last week to 1,052,300 this week.

In Bago West, 2,679 people from Minhla Township were newly displaced within the same township due to intensified fighting, including arson attacks and arbitrary arrests following the enforcement/advancement of MAF troops.

In Kayin State, 3,000 people from Waw Lay area, Myawaddy Township were newly displaced within the same township due to intensified fighting, including indiscriminate shelling following the Ethnic Armed Groups' (EAOs) attacks on the Tatmadaw camps in the area.

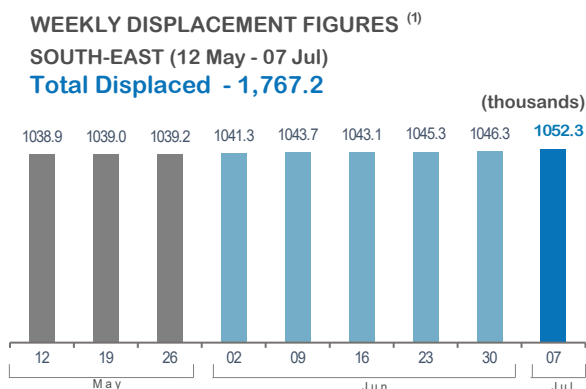
In Shan State (South), 1,027 people from Pekon Township were newly displaced to Nyaungshwe and west of Demoso and Pekon Township due to shelling and the re-control of Moebye Town by the Tatmadaw. Additionally, 343 IDPs from the eastern part of Pekon Township were displaced for a second time to the western part due to shelling and drone attacks. Meanwhile, 731 IDPs returned to Loikaw Township.
