

## 320 people killed in January 2020

1-FEBRUARY-2020 BY SHRC ADMIN



The Syrian Human Rights Committee (SHRC) has documented the death of (320) people during the month of January 2020, including: (74) children, (32) women, and (8) killed under torture.

The regime forces were responsible for the killing of (109) people, the Russian air force was also responsible for the death of (109) people, while the SDF was responsible for the killing of (11) people, the opposition factions were responsible for the killing of (6) people, and the Turkish gendarmerie was responsible for the death of (4) people.

SHRC has documented the killing of (30) assassinations by unknown persons, (15) people as a result of the explosion of landmines, and (10) people as a result of the explosion of improvised explosive devices and booby-traps.

Idlib Governorate came at the forefront of the governorates in terms of the number of victims, as SHRC recorded the killing of 148 people in it, followed by Aleppo Governorate with 81 people, Raqqa Governorate with 33 people, and Deir ez-Zor with 26 people.

The total number of victims in Rif Dimashq governorate was (11), (9) in Daraa Governorate, (8) in Al-Hasakeh governorate, (2) in Al-Suwayda governorate, and (1) in each of the governorates of Homs and Hama.
