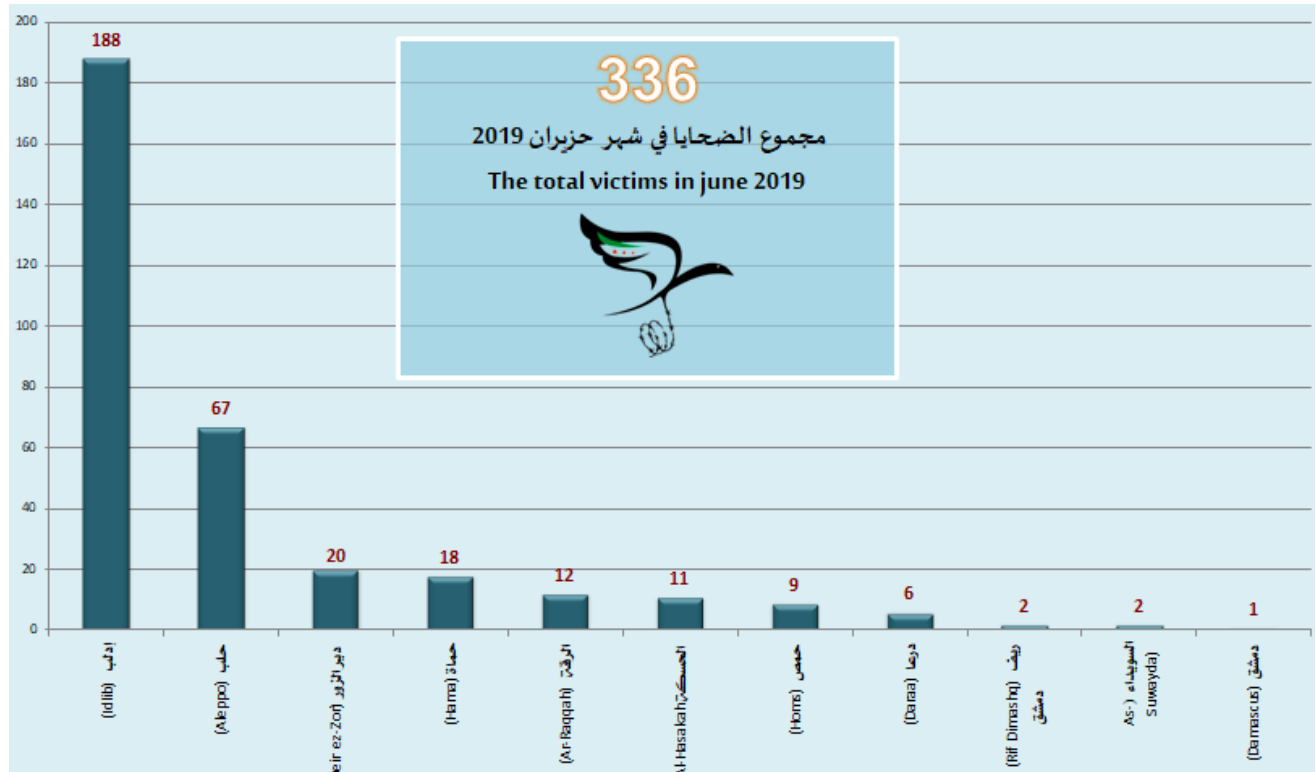

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SHRC documents the death of 336 people in June

The Syrian Human Rights Committee (SHRC) documented the death of 336 people in June 2019. They included 80 children, 47 women and 15 people who were killed under torture.

The Syrian regime forces were responsible for the killing of 207 people, the Russian air forces killed 4 persons, the international coalition air forces killed 3 persons and the Israeli air forces killed 2 persons, ISIS killed 4 persons and Turkish gendarmerie killed 3 persons. The opposition factions killed 2 persons and the Kurdish militias killed 1 person.

Forty three (43) people were killed due to the explosion of improvised explosive devices and car bombs, 19 people were assassinated by unknown persons, 15 were killed by landmines and 2 persons died due to lack of health and medical care in al-Rukban camp on the Syrian-Jordanian border.

The province of Idlib came first in the number of victims. As they reached 188 people followed by Aleppo province with 67 people, Deir ez-Zor Province with 20 persons and Hama Province with 18 persons.

The total number of victims in al-Raqqa province reached 12, 11 in al-Hasakeh, 9 in Homs, 6 in Daraa, 2 each in Rif Dimashq and al-Suwayda provinces, and 1 in the capital Damascus.
