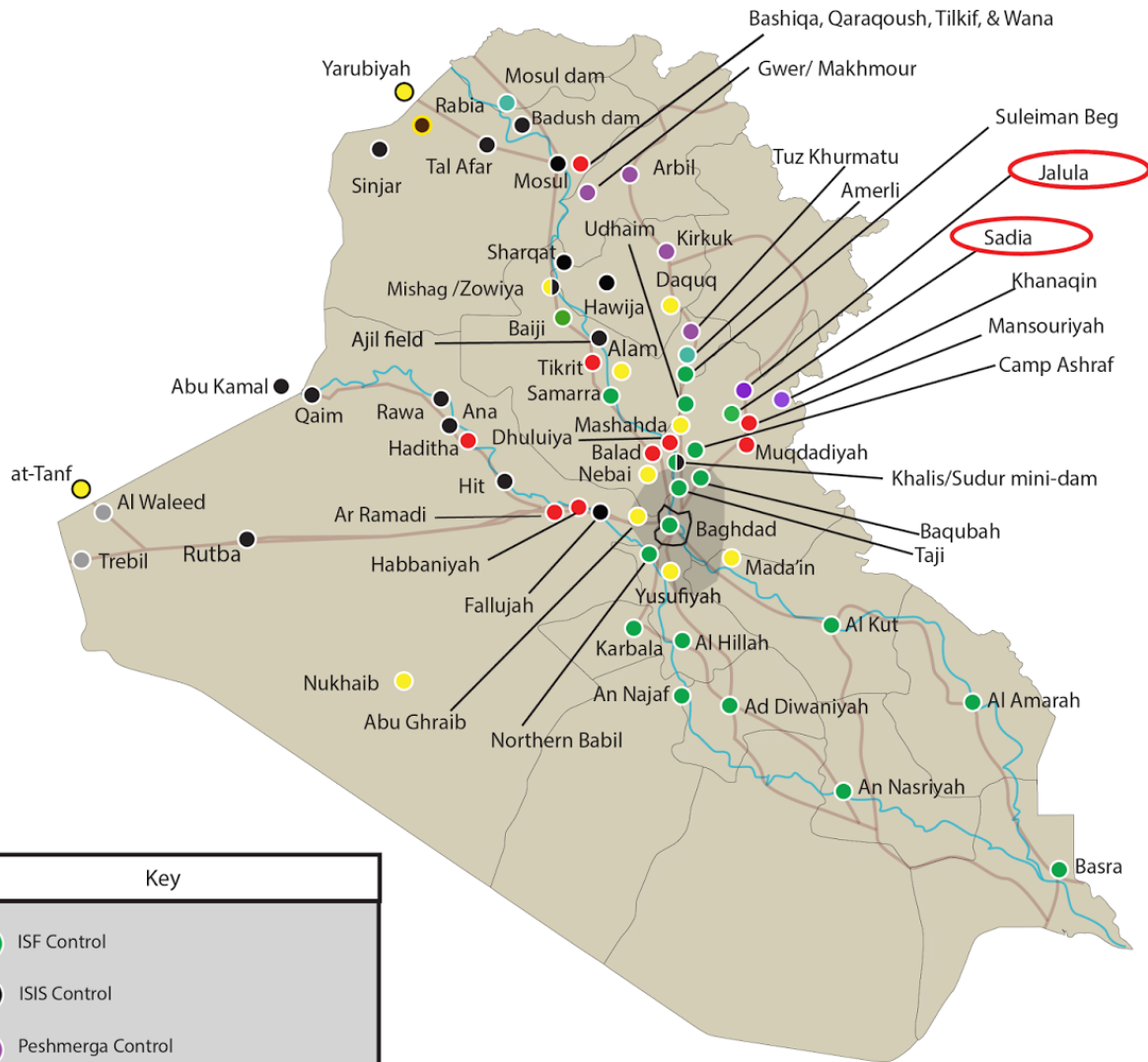

**Changes for November 24, 2014 Update:** On November 23, Iraqi Kurdish Peshmerga, Iraqi Security Forces (ISF), and Popular Mobilization Units (PMUs) that include Iraqi Shi'a militias cleared the Islamic State of Iraq and al-Sham from the areas of Jalula and Sadia in Diyala province in northeastern Iraq. ISIS has been in control of Jalula since August of this year while Sadia's center was controlled by ISIS and its environs were contested since June. The Peshmerga are now the major force in control of Jalula while the ISF and PMUs are mostly in control of Sadia. Therefore, ISW is changing their status.
