WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) increased from 825,100 last week to 833,900 this week.

In Kayin State, 7,791 people from Hpapun and Kawkareik townships were displaced to Hlaingbwe, as well as within the same townships due to intensified fighting. Among them, 4,700 people were displaced as a secondary displacement.

In Mon State, 5,304 people from Kyaikmaraw and Kawkareik townships were displaced to Mawlamyine, Chaungzon, and within Kyaikmaraw Township due to increased fighting, including airstrikes and shelling. Among them, 156 people were displaced as a secondary displacement.

In Kayah State, 1,442 people from Loikaw Township were displaced to Demoso and Hpasawng townships as a secondary displacement.

In Shan State (South), 1,095 people from Loikaw Township were displaced to Pinlaung Township due to fighting, airstrikes, and shelling. Among them, 560 IDPs were displaced as a secondary displacement.
