WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) increased by 5,600 individuals, from 711,100 last week to 716,700 this week. In Kayah State, due to airstrikes, 332 IDPs from Hsihseng Township were displaced to Loikaw Township.

In Shan State (South), 750 IDPs from Loikaw Township, 1,242 IDPs from Hsihseng Township, and 430 IDPs from Pekon Township were displaced to Taunggyi. Additionally, 445 IDPs from Hsihseng Township were displaced to Mawkmai Township, and 1641 IDPs from Hsihseng Township were displaced within the same Township due to intensified fighting, including airstrikes and shelling. Among the 4,508 IDPs in Loikaw, Hsihseng and Pekon townships, 2331 IDPs were displaced as a secondary displacement within Hsihseng Township.

In Kayin State, due to fighting nearby village, 306 IDPs from Kawkareik Township were displaced within the same Township.

In Tanintharyi Region, 4,355 IDPs from Tanintharyi Township were displaced within the same Township due to increased fighting. However, 280 IDPs from Dawei Township and 1,260 IDPs from Thayetchaung Township returned to their places of origin within the same Township.
