LIBANON. Asylsag - UNRWA's
kendskab til asylansøgere.

Udlændingestyrelsen (US) har i forbindelse med behandlingen af konkrete asylansøgninger fra en familie på tolv personer, der oplyser de har syrisk statsborgerskab, anmodet Udenrigsministeriet om assistance med at indhente oplysninger.

Under iagttagelse af sædvanlige sikkerhedsforanstaltninger har Udenrigsministeriet og ambassaden i Libanon indhentet følgende oplysninger:

1. Are the applicants known by UNRWA in Ein al-Hilweh?

- *UNRWA couldn't trace any registration in the name of [redacted] and his family in UNRWA records.*

1.1. If the applicants are known by UNRWA, are they registered by UNRWA, i.e. they are not Syrian citizens but Palestinians?

1.1.1. If the applicants are registered as Palestinians by UNRWA, could UNRWA kindly provide the following information about each applicant: a) place of birth, b) date of registration by UNRWA, c) date of entry and exit into/from Lebanon, d) basis for stay in Lebanon, e) if the applicant has applied for a residence permit in Lebanon, e) if the applicant has been granted a residence permit in Lebanon?

1.2. If the applicants are known but not registered by UNRWA, can UNRWA confirm that the applicants are known as Syrian citizens?

1.3. If the applicants are not known by UNRWA, is it possible to confirm via another confidential source that the family actually lived in Ein al-Hilweh and that they are known as Syrian citizens?

2. Written sources indicate that it is possible to stay as illegal immigrant in Ein al-Hilweh for several years, can UNRWA confirm that these sources reflect reality and that it is plausible that the applicants in concern have lived as illegal immigrants in Ein al-Hilweh from 1994/2005 to 2015?

- *UNRWA confirmed that it is plausible that, due to lack of rule of law mechanisms in camps, people have stayed in Ein El Hilweh camp for several years without valid legal documentation. In general, camps are considered as environments where law enforcement is extremely weak and Lebanese national authorities do not access them: these elements*

make them as ideal environment for people (Palestinians and non) to avoid any interaction with the authorities.
