WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of IDPs slightly increased from 538,700 last week to 538,800 this week.

In Bago Region (East), ongoing conflict and aerial attacks forced 1,700 IDPs from villages in Kyaukkyi Township to flee within the same Township.

In Kayin State, some 200 IDPs from Kyainseikgyi Township were displaced within the same Township due to the intensified fighting near their village. Among them close to 80 IDPs were displaced as a secondary displacement. I

n Kayah State, due to conflict, airstrikes, shelling, and food shortages, some 150 IDPs from Demoso, Hproso, and Thandaunggyi (Yar Do Area) Townships were displaced during the reporting period. Among them, close to 130 IDPs were displaced as a secondary displacement.

Across the border, about 7,200 people from Myanmar remain displaced in Mae Hong Son Province, Thailand.
