9-DECEMBER-2017 BY ADMIN2

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Saturday 09/12/2017 reached 12 deaths. Among the victims were two children.

In Ar-Raqqah, seven civilians were killed in a mine explosion remnants of ISIS planted in the town and neighbourhoods of Ar-Raqqah.

Furthermore, two died in Daraa; one in a bomb explosion while attempting to dismantle a wall during clashes with the regime.

An additional two civilians were killed in Deir Azzour, one in a bomb explosion remnant in the town of al-Sha'fa, and the other in shelling on the town of Sawidan Jazeera. A civilian was also killed as a result of a mine explosion in the town of Abu al-Thuhur (Idlib).

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Friday 08/12 reached 23 deaths including four children and two women.

In Deir Azzour, nine civilians were killed, five executed at the hands of the regime in al-Nejma neighbourhood after they were found hiding in a house, and four in shelling on the village of Baghuz and the town of Sawidan Jazeera.

Furthermore, seven died in Idlib, six in Russian shelling on the village of al-Zarzur, and artillery shelling on the town of al-Hawija.

In addition, a civilian was killed in Hama in shelling on al-Barudiya camp (Hama), and a shelling on the town of Jab Abyad (Aleppo).

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Thursday 07/12/2017 reached 13 deaths. Among the victims were two children.

In Ar-Raqqah, seven civilians were killed in a mine explosion remnant of ISIS at the hotspots and neighbourhoods in Ar-Raqqah.

Furthermore, two died in Deir Azzour at the crossings in the town of al-Bahra and al-Shaykh. In addition, four were executed at the hands of Khalid al-Mabya' army (belonging to ISIS) on charges of belonging to the Free army in the town of Taseel (Daraa).

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Wednesday reached 38 deaths. Among the victims were four children.

In Deir Azzour, 29 civilians were killed; 23 in Russian shelling on the town of al-Jardi, the artillery shelling on the town of al-Sha'fa, and three shot by ISIS for refusing to evacuate the mosque and the house of the organization's members.

Furthermore, four were killed in rural Damascus, three in shelling on Arbeen and Saqba in clashes with government forces.

In addition, three died in Ar-Raqqah in a landmine explosion remnant of ISIS. A further three were killed as a result of mine explosions remnants of ISIS in the Syrian desert of al-Hazm (Homs).

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Tuesday 05/12/2017 reached 36 deaths including a child and eight women.

In Homs, ten civilians were killed as a result of a bomb explosion in a car carrying passengers in the Akrama al-Mawali neighbourhood (Homs).

An additional ten civilians were killed in Hama as a result of clashes in rural Hama.

Furthermore, five died in rural Damascus, four in shelling on Arbeen, Humuriya and Air and one in clashes with government forces. A further three civilians were killed in a bomb attack by reconnaissance aircraft targeting Jobar neighbourhood (southern Damascus).

The killings of five civilians were documented in Deir Azzour, four in shelling on the town of Sha'fa and Hajeen River crossing, and one shot by Qasbi militia. The killings of three civilians were documented as a result of a mine explosion remnant of ISIS in Ar-Raqqah.

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Monday 04/12/2017 reached 12 deaths.

In Deir Azzour, five civilians were killed; three in shelling on the town of al-Sayal and al-Sayal shot during clashes between ISIS and Qasid militia, and one shot by Turkish border guards.

An additional five civilians were killed in rural Damascus, three in clashes with government forces and two in shelling on Douma and the town of Ain Tarma.

The killing of a civilian was documented at one of the points located in Hama, and another was the result of a landmine explosion in Al-Hassaka.

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Sunday 03/12/2017 reached 48 deaths including 13 children and three women.

In rural Damascus, 28 civilians were killed; 25 in shelling on the towns and cities of eastern Damascus distributed as follows: 16 in Humuriya, four in Arbeen, three in Bait Sawa, one in Haras Masraba. Two civilians were killed in a landmine explosion in eastern al-Qalmun, and one as a result of drought and malnutrition due to the siege imposed on eastern Ghouta.

Furthermore, six were killed in Ar-Raqqah as a result of a landmine explosion while they were searching their homes in Ar-Raqqah. A further five civilians were killed in Idlib, four in a landmine explosion, and the other in shelling on rural Idlib.

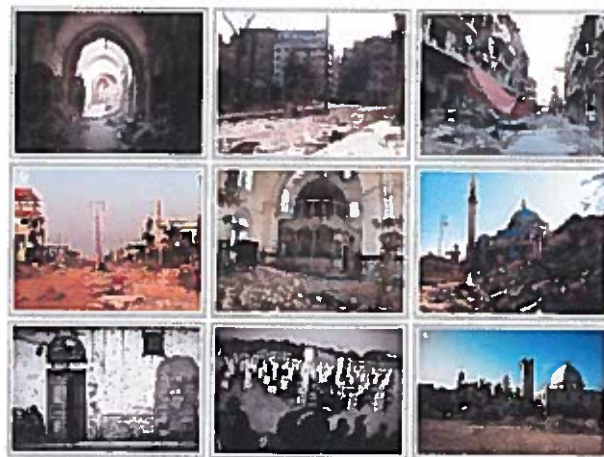
The killings of four civilians were documented in Deir Azzour, two as a result of previous shelling on Deir Azzour, one in international alliance shelling on the town of Granij, and a child soldier of the Qasd militia who targeted his family's vehicle in Badia al-Jazeera. The killings of another five civilians were documented in clashes with government forces in Homs.

The commission documented the killings of two civilians in a bomb explosion in Hama. was also killed in a landmine explosion in the village of al-Hajaa (Aleppo).

In Damascus, 11 civilians were killed as a result of shelling on the towns and cities distributed as follows: seven in Arbeen, two in Harasta, and two in Masraba.

In addition, six died in Deir Azzour, five in shelling on the town of Abu Hamam and the town of Salhiya and one as a result of clashes between ISIS and the regime in the village of al-

Furthermore, two were killed in Daraa, one in a bomb explosion and the other in shelling in al-Balad. A civilian was also killed in clashes with government forces in Jobar neighbourhood (southern Damascus).

The killings of two civilians were documented as a result of a mine explosion remnant of the conflict in Raqqah. A civilian was also documented in clashes with government forces in Hama.

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Thursday 30 November reached 22 deaths including two children, a woman, and one killed under torture.

In Ar-Raqqah, eight civilians were killed as a result of landmine explosions carried out by the opposition forces planted in the homes and neighbourhoods of Ar-Raqqah.

Furthermore, three were killed in rural Damascus, two in clashes with government forces and one in shelling.

In addition, four died in Hama; two shot by an unknown source northern Mawrak, one in al-Latamina, and one in clashes with government forces.

A further two civilians were killed in Idlib at the hands of unknown assailants in Jisr al-Sabi farms. Three civilians also died in Deir Azzour; one in shelling, the other in a landmine explosion and one under torture in Sednaya military prison.

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Wednesday reached 23 deaths including two children and two women.

In rural Damascus, seven civilians were killed; five in shelling on the cities and towns of Ghouta, one shot by an ISIS sniper, and one due to the lack of medicines for thalassen the siege imposed by the regime forces on eastern Ghouta.

Furthermore, six died in Deir Azzour, five in shelling on al-Baq'an and al-Jalaa river crossing two in a mine explosion remnant of ISIS.

In addition, ten were killed in Ar-Raqqah, nine in a mine explosion remnant of ISIS in different neighbourhoods, and one shot by a sniper and his body was found 4 months after his disappearance.

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Tuesday 28/11/2017 reached 26 deaths. Among the victims were five children.

In Deir Azzour, 15 civilians were killed, 13 in shelling on al-Hasraat, al-Baq'an and al-Ahmediyah river crossings, and two in a mine explosion remnants of ISIS in the town of al-Baq'an.

Furthermore, eight died in rural Damascus; six in shelling on the towns of Humuriya, Madaya, Madira, one shot by the regime, and one in clashes with government forces.

In addition, two died as a result of landmine explosion remnants of ISIS, one in Ar-Raqqa and the other in Al-Hassaka. A civilian was also shot by a regime sniper in al-Birqadar (Damascus).

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Monday 27/11 reached 65 deaths including 14 children and six women.

In Deir Azzour, 32 civilians were killed; 29 in shelling on the cities and town of Deir Azzour and three in Darnaj, al-Baghuz and al-Ghabra. In addition, one civilian was drowned in Euphrates River while attempting to flee.

In addition, 24 civilians were killed in rural Damascus; 19 in shelling on the towns of eastern Ghouta – they were distributed as follows: nine in Madira, five in Douma, three in Masra, and one in Arbeen. A further six civilians were killed in clashes with government forces.

Furthermore, four died in Ar-Raqqah in a mine explosion remnant of ISIS. A further two were killed in Hama as a result of a missile explosion in al-Latamina.

The killings of two civilians were documented in Homs in clashes with government forces. The killing of a civilian was documented in a bomb explosion in the village of al-Zahra (Idlib).

In Deir Azzour, 30 civilians were killed; 25 in Russian shelling on the town of al-Sha'fa (near Sunrise), four in shelling on the town of Darnaj, and one from wounds sustained in shelling of the camps in the town of al-Sayal.

Furthermore, 29 died in rural Damascus, 26 in shelling on the towns of al-Ghouta district follows: 16 in Masraba, seven in Madira, and three in Douma. A civilian was shot by ISIS in the town of Yalda, and another civilian killed in clashes with government forces.

In addition, five died in Ar-Raqqah in a landmine explosion planted by ISIS at his home on the Raqqah roads.

In Deir Azzour, 20 civilians were killed, 18 in shelling on al-Hasaraat river crossing and of al-Baghuz, eastern and western al-Jarhi and the village of Hardub, and two in mine remnants of ISIS.

Furthermore, 12 died in rural Damascus, 11 in shelling on Arbeen, Douma, Harista and of Tarma, Masraba and Jisreen, and one in clashes with government forces.

In addition, five died in Ar-Raqqah, four in mine explosion remnants of ISIS, and one for his home after it was broken in to.

A civilian was killed in Aleppo, after he was arrested by the Free Northern Brigade, and of belonging to ISIS. A civilian was also killed in Idlib as a result of a motorbike explosion another in Al-Hassaka after his health deteriorated in al-Sad camp.

In rural Damascus, eight civilians were killed; five in shelling on Arbeen and the town of al-Bukamal, two poisoned with salt-like material sold in the markets, and one in clashes with government forces.

Furthermore, three died in Deir Azzour, two in a landmine explosion in the village of al-Bukamal and one in shelling on al-Bukamal. An additional three civilians were killed in Ar-Raqqa result of several landmine explosions remnants of ISIS.

The killing of a member of the civil defense was documented in Idlib, assassinated at the hands of unknown assailants. A civilian was also killed in al-Yarmouk camp in Damascus because of illness and delay in taking her out of the al-Aruba – Yalda checkpoint to transfer her to hospitals for treatment.

Furthermore, four died in Deir Azzour, three in shelling on Sawh al-Rafa'i (rural al-Buka) and one shot by a regime sniper while crossing Euphrates river.

A civilian was killed in Ar-Raqqah, in a mine explosion remnant of ISIS in ar-Rad'ya neighbourhood. The killing of a child was documented in Al-Hassaka as a result of the shelling weather and the lack of medical care in al-Sad camp.

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Monday 20/11 reached 35 deaths including 12 children and two women.

In rural Damascus, 15 civilians were killed; 11 in shelling on the towns of Kafr Batna, M Humriya and Arbeen, two as a result of the siege on eastern al-Ghouta, one suffered from a heart condition and died from the lack of the necessary doses of medication, and a child suffered from a heart condition and was refused to be taken to Damascus for treatment. A civilian was also killed in a mortar explosion in the regime, and another died in mine explosion remnants of Hezbollah militia.

Furthermore, eight died in Damascus in mortar shelling from an unknown source on Ba Jarmana and Khaled Ibn al-Waleed and al-Fayhaa.

In addition, four died in Deir Azzour, three in a car bomb explosion near the village of a one in a landmine explosion remnant of ISIS. A child was also killed as a result of the lack of medical care in Ain Isa camp (Ar-Raqqah).

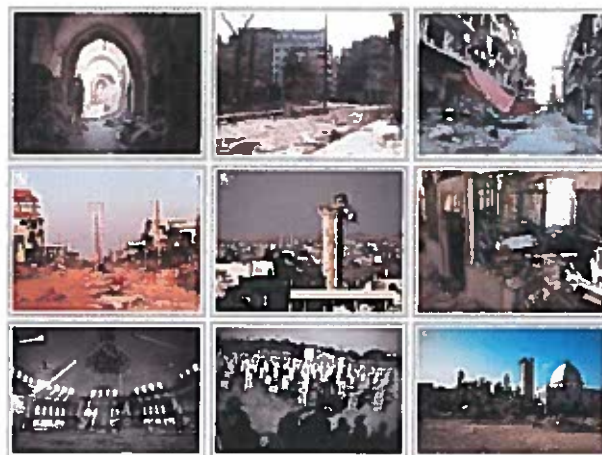

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Sunday 19/11 reached 35 deaths including five children and a woman.

In rural Damascus, 24 civilians were killed; 18 in shelling on the towns of eastern al-Ghuta were distributed as follows: six in Douma, six in the town of Madira, and one in Humuriya and Arbeen. Six civilians were also killed in clashes with government forces.

Furthermore, three died in Hama, two in clashes with government forces, and one shot by unknown assailants on al-Shari'a road.

In addition, four died in Deir Azzour in shelling on al-Baq'an and Al-Jalaa-Al-Hajeen river crossings. A civilian was also killed as a result of the lack of medical care in al-Sad car (near Hassaka).

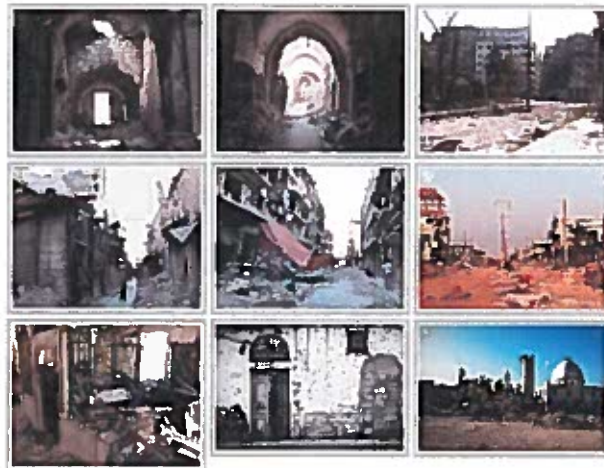
The killing of a civilian was documented in shelling on Jobar neighbourhood (southern I and a civilian was also killed in a landmine explosion in Ar-Raqqah. In addition, the killii civilian was documented in Idlib, shot by unknown assailants in the town of al-Tah.

In rural Damascus, 20 civilians were killed, 19 in shelling on the town of eastern Ghouta as follows: six in Madira, four in Hazza, three in Kafr Hawr, two in Harista and Humuriya, Bait Tayma and Douma, and one in clashes with government forces.

Furthermore, three died in Deir Azzour; one in warplane shelling on the town of al-'Ash. Qasd militia shelling on the town of Abu Hamam, and one as a result of burns from mine explosions remnants of ISIS. The killings of two civilians were documented as a result of explosions remnants of ISIS in Ar-Raqqah.

The killing of a civilian was documented in shelling on the town of Jabata al-Khashb (Al-Jabata al-Khashb). The killing of another civilian was documented in clashes with government forces in Ha

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Friday 17/11 reached 52 deaths including 13 children and five women.

In rural Damascus, 24 civilians were killed, 23 in shelling on the towns and villages of Ghouta. They were distributed as follows: 13 civilians in shelling on Douma city, including members of the Civil Defense, four in Harista and Arbeen, and one in Madira and al-Sharbiya and one in clashes with government forces in Bait Jan.

Furthermore, 20 died in Deir Azzour; 13 in shelling on the towns of al-Sawsaw, al-Ghat refugee camp in Fida Jab, four as a result of an explosion believed to have been organized on a group of refugees from Deir Azzour at one of Qasd militia barriers, three in a landmine explosion, and two executed at the hands of ISIS under charges of carrying out magic ; insulting God.

In addition, four were killed in Idlib as a result of two bomb explosions, one in a motorbi Sheikhoun road, and the other near al-Mihrab roundabout (Idlib). Two civilians were als mortar shelling on al-Dawila'a and al-Haal market (Damascus).

The killings of two civilians were documented in a landmine explosion remnant of ISIS i Raqqah. Names of victims documented by the Syrian Human Rights committee can be the Arabic section.

Furthermore, 18 died in Deir Azzour, seven in shelling on Sawh al-Fara'l camp on 14/11 in shelling on the towns of al-Ashara, Sabikhan, the village of Daranj and Hawij Kati'.

In addition, two were killed in Ar-Raqqah, one in a landmine explosion and the other as a result of a severe beating at the hands of Turkish border guards, where he died in Hospital. A civilian was also killed in a mine explosion in the town of Markada (Al-Hassaka).

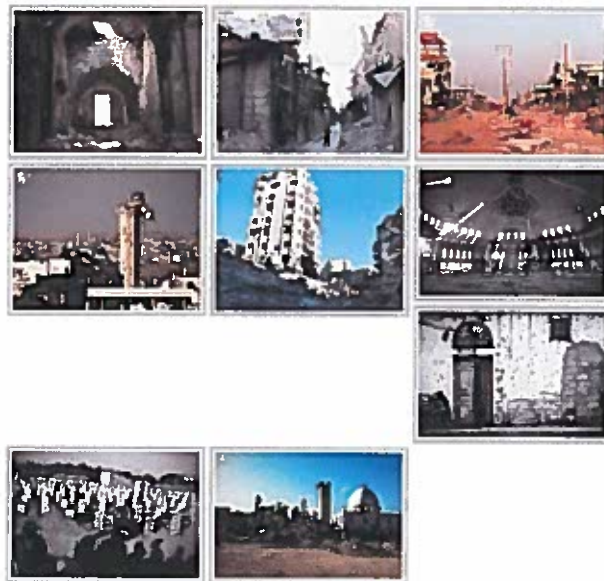

In Deir Azzour, 31 civilians were killed; 17 in shelling on al-Sha'fa, al-Susa, al-Sabikhar Baq'an crossings, eight in shelling on the towns of al-Sabikhan, al-Baghuz, al-Sayal and eight in shelling on a refugee camp near the town of al-Sukariya on 11/11/2017.

Furthermore, two died in Al-Hassaka, one shot by Qasd militia while attempting to return home in the village of al-Shateeh, and another under torture in Sednaya military prison. One was killed in Idlib, as a result of severe beating he was subjected to by Turkish border guards while trying to cross into Turkish territory.

The killings of three civilians were documented in Ar-Raqqah, as a result of a mine explosion remnant of ISIS. The killings of another two civilians were documented in Aleppo, as a result of shelling on the outskirts of the town of Urum al-Kubra.

Furthermore, 15 died in Al-Hassaka as a result of international alliance shelling on the town of Da'ij, followed by the targeting of an ambulance trying to rescue the injured.

In addition, three were killed in Ar-Raqqah in a landmine explosion remnant of ISIS. Another three civilians were killed in Homs, two children in ar-Rukban camp (a newborn due to health care, and the other due to shortness of breath and refused transfer to the UNICEF point) and one in shelling on ar-Rastan.

The killings of two civilians were documented in Idlib, as a result of Russian shelling on Taman'a. The killings of another two civilians were documented in Hama, one in shellin town of Shizar, and the other in clashes with government forces.

The commission also documented the killings of three civilians in a mine explosion rem in Ar-Raqqah, and a civilian in Daraa as a result of a bomb explosion. A civilian was als mortar shelling on Jarmana (Damascus).

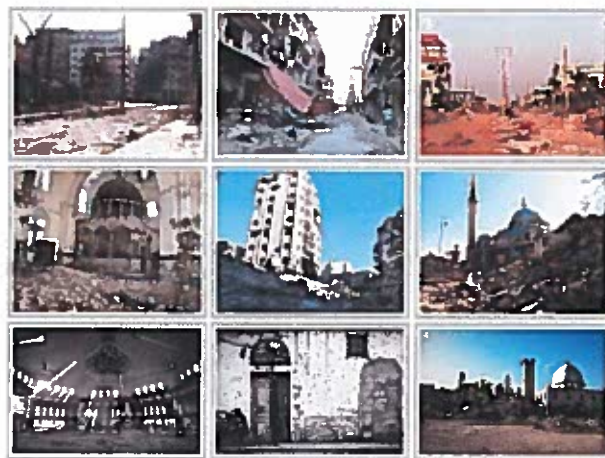

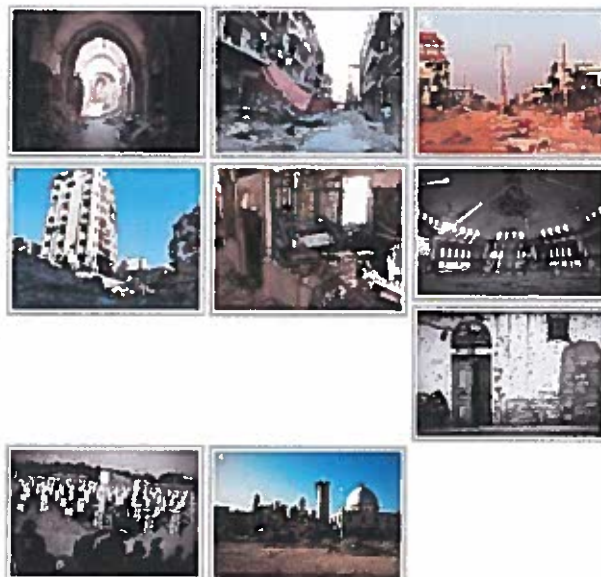

Furthermore, eight were killed in Idlib, four executed at one of the headquarters, shot by government assailants, and four children as a result of a bomb explosion remnants of Russian shell in the town of Kafr Sajna.

A further five civilians were killed in Al-Quneitra in clashes with government forces in the town of Hadr (rural Al-Quneitra).

In addition, two died in Damascus, one due to the lack of medical care as a result of the al-Yarmouk camp, and the other shot by a sniper in al-Qadm neighbourhood and his health deteriorated due to the lack of doctors in the neighbourhood. A civilian also died as a result of the deterioration of his health due to cancer and the lack of necessary medication due to the siege imposed on eastern al-Ghouta.

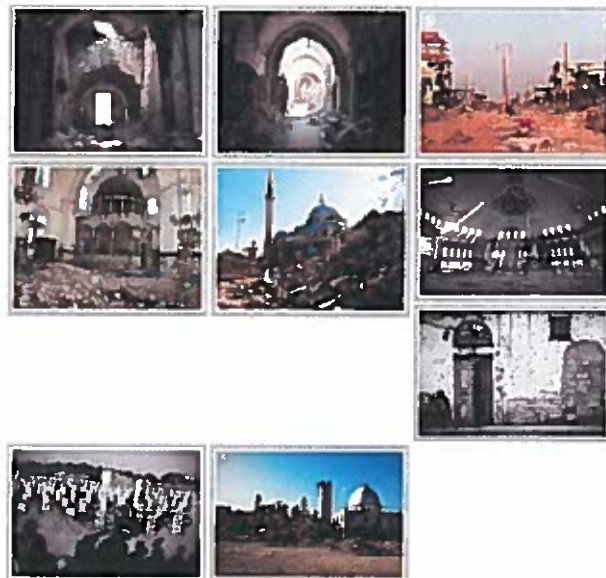

Daily Report on Violations of Human Rights in 02/11/2017

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Thursday 2/11/2017 reached 49 deaths including 15 children and four women.

In Deir Azzour, 36 civilians were killed; 21 in shelling on the town of al-Salahiya (rural) and 12 in shelling on the towns of al-Sayal, Ashayir, Hajeen and al-Basira (rural Deir Azzour). Three in shelling on Hawija Kati' by regime artillery.

Furthermore, eight died in rural Damascus; six in shelling on Douma, one from wounds in previous shelling in the town of Masraba, and a child as a result of kidney failure and lack of medicine due to the siege imposed on eastern Ghouta.

In addition, a civilian died in Hama as a result of clashes with government forces. A civilian was also killed at the hands of unknown assailants near the village of al-Dariya at the Syrian border (Idlib).

The killing of a civilian was documented as a result of the lack of medical care in al-Sac Hassaka). The killing of another civilian was documented in Ar-Raqqah as a result of his deterioration resulting from enduring one year and a half of torture in regime controlled prison.

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Wednesday reached 19 deaths including two children and four women.

In Deir Azzour, 16 civilians were killed; ten in warplane shelling on the towns of al-Saya Sawi'ya and al-Ghabra, three in artillery shelling from the Iraqi side in the village of al-F shot by Qasd militia, and one from wounds sustained in shelling on al-Qawriya barrier a

Furthermore, two died in Damascus, a child due to the lack of medicine and suffering from convulsions as a result of the ongoing siege on Yarmouk camp, and the other in clashes. A civilian was also killed in Hama, as a result of regime artillery shelling in al-Latamina.
