## SHRC documents 77 death in December 2020

2-JANUARY-2021 BY SHRC ADMIN



The Syrian Human Rights Committee documented the killing of (77) people in Syria during the month of December 2020, including: (15) children, (2) women, and (13) people who died under torture.

The Syrian regime forces were responsible for killing (19) people, while the Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) were responsible for the killing of (5) people, and the opposition factions were responsible for the killing of (3) people, and Iranian militias were responsible for the killing of (1) person.

SHRC documented the killing of (29) people by unidentified hands, (14) people due to the explosion of IEDs and booby traps, and (7) people due to the explosion of landmines. A girl died due to lack of health care in Al-Hol camp in Al-Hasakah.

Deir ez-Zor province topped the rest of the provinces in terms of the number of victims, which reached (20) people, followed by Daraa province with (15) people, and then Aleppo province with (13) people.

The total number of victims in each of the provinces of Hama and Al Hasaka reached (7) persons each, (6) persons in each of the provinces of Idlib and Raqqa, two persons in AsSuwayda province, and one person in Homs province.
