WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) increased from 917,100 last week to 922,100 this week.

As a result of increased fighting in Shan State (North), 7,001 people from Lashio Township were displaced to Taunggyi, Nyaungshwe, Lawksawk, Pindaya, Laihka and Mongkaing townships in Shan State (South). Additionally, 432 people were displaced from Hsihseng to Nyaungshwe Township.

In Bago Region (East), 320 people were displaced from Me Ba Lan Village Tract, Htantabin Township to Taungoo Town due to intensified fighting.

In Bago Region (West), 500 people from Kyaung Ywar Village Tract, Minhla Township were newly displaced within the same Township over the past two weeks.

In Tanintharyi Region, 3,229 people returned to their places of origin in Thayetchaung and Launglon townships, respectively.
