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The Syrian Human Rights Committee documented the killing of (110) individuals in Syria during the month of December 2023, including (21) women, (13) children, and (3) who were killed under torture.

The Assad regime was responsible for the death of (32) individuals, while Russian airstrikes and the Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) were responsible for the death of (5) individuals each. Opposition factions were responsible for the killing of (4) individuals, and the Turkish border guards (Gendarmerie) were responsible for the death of (3) individuals.

SHRC also documented the assassination of (36) individuals by unknown assailants, (10) individuals due to the explosion of improvised explosive devices and the aftermath of shelling, and (10) individuals due to landmine explosions.

Daraa province had the highest number of victims, totaling (25) individuals, followed by Aleppo and Idlib provinces with (22) individuals each, and then Deir ez-Zor province with (20) individuals.

The total number of victims in Homs province was (9) individuals, (6) individuals in Suwaida province, (4) individuals in Hasakah province, and (1) individual in each of Raqqa and Hama provinces.
