SEP 10, 2017

Iraqi Military Forces

- Found and cleared armored vehicles and IEDs belonging to ISIS in Zawra area west of Samarra in Salah Al-Din.
- Destroyed IED belts which were found in an ISIS den along with other materials and supplies used by the organization in Matbija area in Salah Al-Din.

SEP 11, 2017

Iraqi Military Forces

- Launched a military operation in Qasr Al-Ra'i village west Al-Ayadiya sub-district north of Telafar district which ended with the killing of sixty five ISIS members and fifteen suicide bombers in the village.
- Destroyed four ISIS dens which contained IEDs and IED belts in Qasr Al-Ra'i village west of Al-Ayadiya

sub-district in Telafar district.

Joint Forces repelled an ISIS attack in Al-Mahalabia sub-district west of Mosul and managed to kill eight ISIS members and confiscated six vehicles and weapons belonging to them.

Iraqi Air Forces launched airstrikes on Kuhzayf, Aslaniyah and Um Kasr villages in Hawiga district amid strikes on the town itself which killed seven and injured four of ISIS members and destroyed many ISIS bases and weapon storages in Kirkuk.

SEP 12, 2017

Iraqi Military Forces found and cleared mortars, an Austrian projectile, shells, and locally made IEDs in Nuwaydar village in Al-Saadiya sub-district of Diyala.

Popular Mobilization Forces

Repelled ISIS attacks in Tal Asfuk area near Iraqi-Syrian border west of Mosul and Ain Baitha village and Zawayah Junction in Salah Al-Din. The forces managed to kills tens of ISIS members and destroyed many improvised vehicles belonging to them.

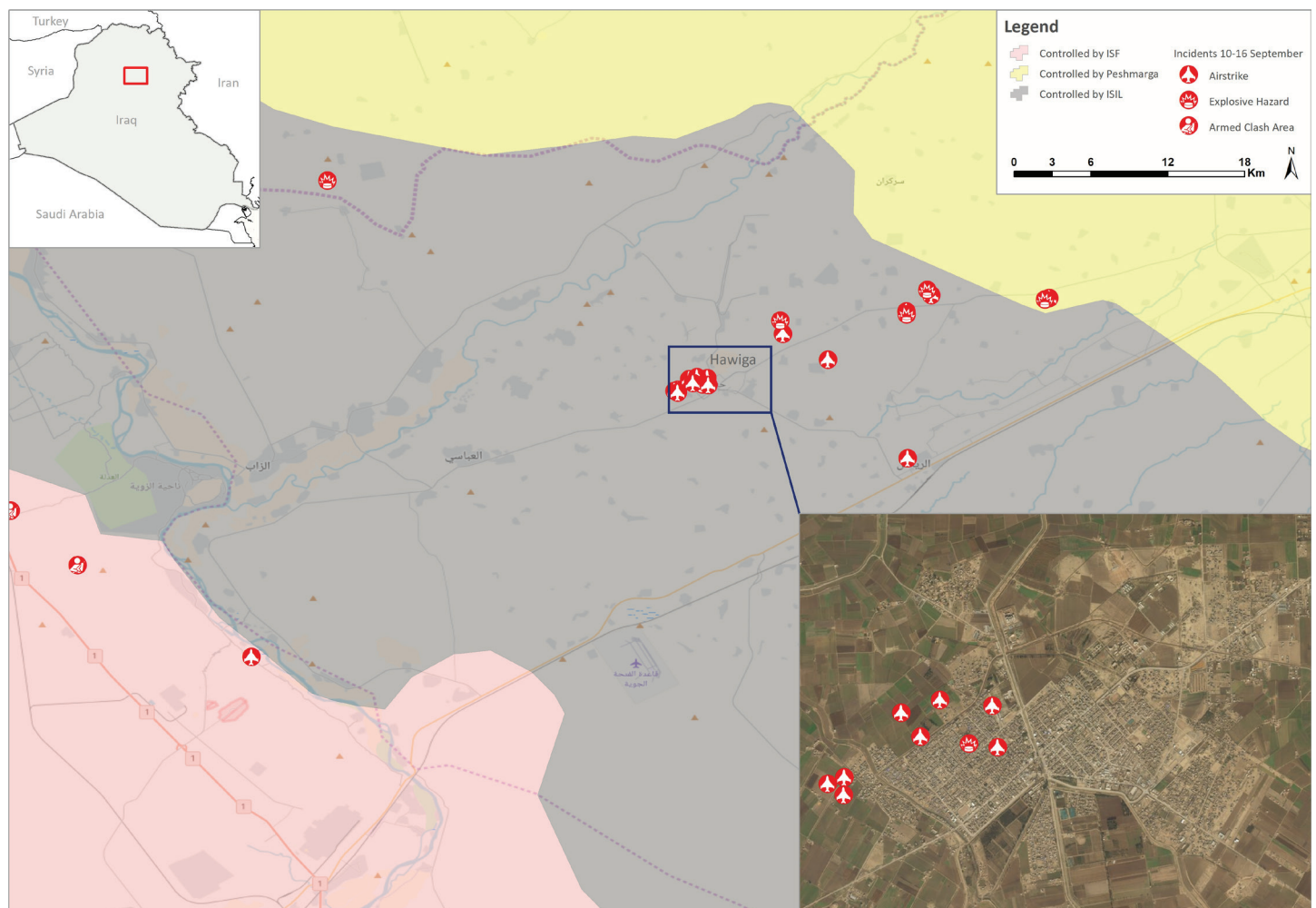
Iraqi Air Forces

Launched strikes on ISIS near Tal Asfuk area in Ba'aj district west of Mosul and Ka'im and Ana districts of Anbar which destroyed many weapon and munition storages belonging to the organization.

ISIS

Two children died and other two injured while playing with IED remnants of ISIS in Imam village in Al-Qayarra sub-district south of Mosul.

SEP 13, 2017

Iraqi Air Forces launched airstrikes on ISIS which killed a commander and four of his companions who were operating in a headquarter in Hawiga district in Kirkuk.

Popular Mobilization Forces

repelled an ISIS attack on Iraqi-Syrian border in the triangle area that links Hamdaniya area with the border towards Ramadi desert in Ninewa.

ISIS destroyed a Korek Telecom tower using TNT in Qarach sub-district of Makhmur district in Erbil.

SEP 14, 2017

Iraqi Military Forces Three civilians were killed and ten others injured due to an unknown airstrike on Ana district in Anbar.

SEP 15, 2017

Iraqi Air Forces launched strikes on an ISIS base west of Rutba in Anbar which led to the killing of the units that were in the base and burned their supplies.

Popular Mobilization Forces

foiled an ISIS sneaking operation in Al-Zawiyah Junction in Salah Al-Din.

ISIS executed three young men in Ka'im city western side of Anbar on charges of communicating with the Security Forces.

Uncategorised armed group

An IED explosion occurred on an agricultural road near Qarataba sub-district in Diyala which led to the death of a farmer.

SEP 16, 2017

Iraqi Military Forces found and cleared two IEDs in A'sakira area northeast Ba'quba district of Diyala.

Joint Forces liberated Akashat sub-district in Anbar after clashes against ISIS.

Uncategorised armed group

- A suicide bomber blew himself in Muqadadiya district in Diyala killed two persons one of them was an officer and injured seven other persons.
- A civilian killed and ten others injured due to a booby-trapped vehicle explosion in Adan neighborhood in Kirkuk.
