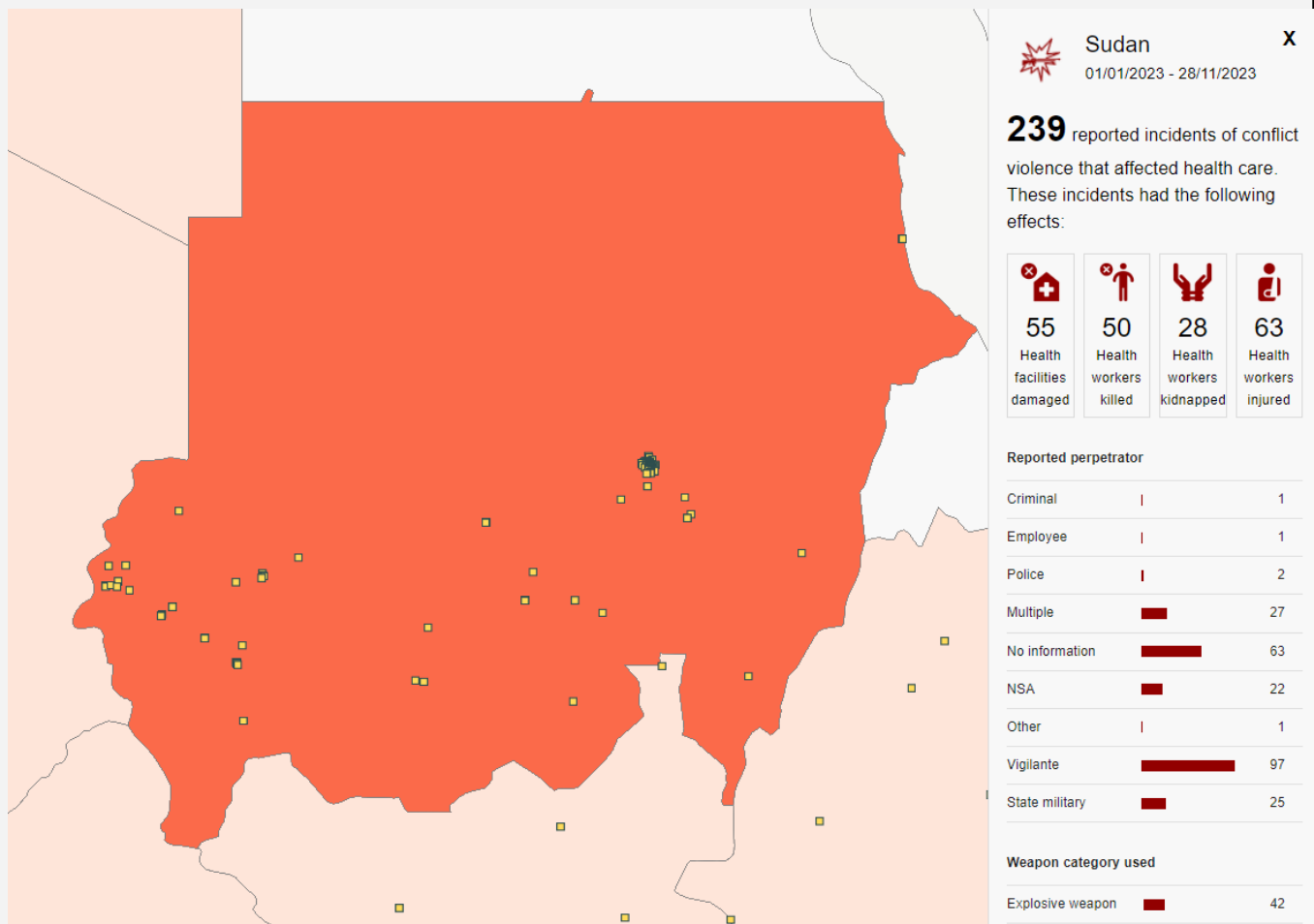
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Attacks on Health Care in Sudan

29 November-12 December 2023



Insecurity Insight has identified at least 239 attacks on Sudan's health care system between 01 January-28 November 2023. In these incidents, 50 health workers have been killed and health facilities have been damaged 55 times. These attacks undermine health care providers' ability to effectively meet patient needs, maintain safe staffing levels and impact the population's access to health care. Documented incidents

As reported on 02 December 2023: In Khartoum city and state, the Soba University Hospital was stormed and looted by the RSF. The catheterization department and all cars were looted, including ambulances and laboratory cars belonging to the University of Khartoum. The Mycetoma Research Center, the central laboratory, the examination centre, the Sati Center for laboratory research, the private wing and the administrative wing were destroyed. **Source:** [Sudan Violations](#)

03 December 2023: In Omdurman city, Khartoum state, a doctor and lecturer at the Faculty of Pharmacy, her two sons and her parents were killed by an artillery shell that fell on their house. **Sources:** [Dabanga Sudan](#) and [Personal Communication](#)

As reported on 06 December 2023: In Khartoum, director of Bashayer Hospital and a member of the emergency room were attacked and threatened by the RSF. In response, staff announced a strike. **Source:** [Sudan Violations](#)

As reported on 06 December 2023: In Al-Ardah district, Omdurman city, Khartoum state, Awad Hussein Hospital was damaged in RSF bombing. **Source:** [Sudan Violations](#)

11 December 2023: In Khartoum state, an unspecified number of hospitals were looted by the RSF and medical equipment taken to Nyala hospital. **Source:** [Sudan Violations](#)
