Monthly Report on Human Rights Violations in February 2024

The Syrian Human Rights Committee (SHRC) documented the killing of (81) individuals in Syria during the month of February 2024, including: (13) children, (5) women, and (4) individuals who died under torture.

The Assad regime was responsible for the killing of (14) individuals, while the Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) were responsible for the killing of (8) individuals. Additionally, Israeli forces through their airstrikes were responsible for the killing of (8) individuals, and both Turkish and Russian forces were responsible for the killing of one person each.

SHRC also documented the assassination of (22) individuals by unknown assailants, (23) individuals due to landmine explosions, and (3) individuals due to the explosion of shelling remnants.

Raqqa province topped the other provinces in terms of casualties, with (20) individuals killed, followed by Deir ez-Zor province with (18) individuals, and then Homs province with (15) individuals.

The total number of casualties in Daraa province was (9) individuals, (7) individuals in Aleppo province, (3) individuals each in Hasakah and Idlib provinces, (2) in Hama province, and only one person each in Damascus, Damascus countryside (Rif Dimashq), Sweida, and Latakia provinces
