Udenrigsministeriet er af Udlændingestyrelsen blevet anmodet om i en konkret asylsag at tilvejebringe oplysninger vedrørende palæstinensiske rejsedokumenter udstedt i Syrien. Udenrigsministeriet vedlægger den med udlændingestyrelsens anmodning bilagte anonymiserede kopi af et syrisk rejsedokument.

Den danske ambassade i Beirut har via en Beirut baseret dokument- og visumrådgiver, specialiseret i syriske dokumenter og visumspørgsmål, fået følgende svar på de af Udlændingestyrelsen stillede spørgsmål:

- ***The Danish Immigration Service sometimes sees travel documents issued by Syrian authorities to registered Palestinian refugees where the Arabic word for travel document (وثيقة سفر) overlaps the national emblem in the left-hand corner on the top of the first page (please find anonymized example attached). Does this overlap indicate that the travel document is not genuine, or is it a common feature seen in genuine passports issued by Syrian authorities?***

According to the Document and Visa Advisor the Arabic word for travel document overlapping the emblem is a common feature and does not in itself indicate that the document is not genuine.

- ***Can Palestinian refugees registered in Syria get their travel documents, issued in Syria, renewed at Syrian consulates in foreign countries (by use of a renewal sticker put in the passport by the consulate)?***

The Danish Embassy is not able to obtain information as to whether Palestinian refugees registered in Syria can get their travel documents, issued in Syria, renewed at Syrian consulates in foreign countries.

The Document and Visa Advisor did confirm though having seen travel documents of Palestinian refugees issued in Syria renewed at the Syrian Embassy in Beirut by using a renewal sticker in the passport.
