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Monthly Report on Human Rights Violations Victims – March 2024

The Syrian Human Rights Committee (SHRC) documented the killing of (101) individuals during the month of March 2024, including: (15) children, (16) women, and one person killed under torture.

The Assad regime was responsible for the killing of (6) individuals, while the Syrian Democratic Forces were responsible for the killing of (5) individuals, and opposition factions were responsible for the killing of (4) individuals.

SHRC documented the killing of (48) individuals by unknown assailants, (19) individuals due to landmine explosions, and (12) individuals due to explosive device detonations.

Deir ez-Zor province topped the other provinces in terms of casualties, reaching (46) individuals, followed by Daraa province with (20) individuals, and then Aleppo province with (19) individuals.

The total fatalities in Raqqa province reached (8) individuals, (3) individuals in each of Idlib and Homs provinces, and (2) in Hasakah province.

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
