## SHRC documents the death of 292 people in April 2019

The Syrian Human Rights Committee documented the death of 292 people during April 2019. Of these, 64 were children, 34 women and 30 persons were killed under torture.

The Syrian regime's forces were responsible for the death of 139 people, the Russian war aircrafts were responsible for the killing of 34 people, ISIS was responsible for the death of three persons and the Kurdish militia of Syrian Democratic forces (SDF) was responsible for the killing of eight persons. The Turkish gendarmerie also killed two people.

The total number of victims killed by mines was 35 and the total number killed by IEDs was 22. 35 people were killed by unknown assailants and 2 due to the lack of medical care and nutrition in Al-Houl camp in al-Hasakeh province.

The province of Idlib came in the forefront in terms of the number of victims, which reached (93) people, followed by the province of Deir ez-Zor (54) people, and then Hama province (51) people, and each of the provinces of Aleppo and Ragga (25) people.

The total number of victims in the province of Rif Dimashq was 20, 10 in Daraa, 4 in Homs, 3 in al-Hasakeh, Quneitra and Damascus, and 1 in Lattakia Province.
