WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of displaced slightly decreased from 545,000 last week to 541,000 this week.

In Kayah State, intensified fighting displaced a total of 851 IDPs in Demoso Township and some 47 IDPs in Shadow Township. Among them, 449 IDPs were displaced as a secondary displacement.

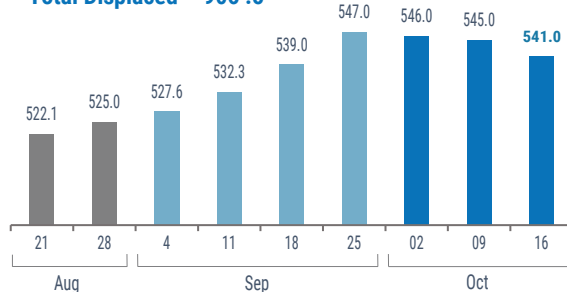
In Mon State, some 4356 IDPs returned to their place of origin in Billin Township.

Across the border, about 7,000 people from Myanmar remain displaced in Mae Hong Son Province, Thailand.

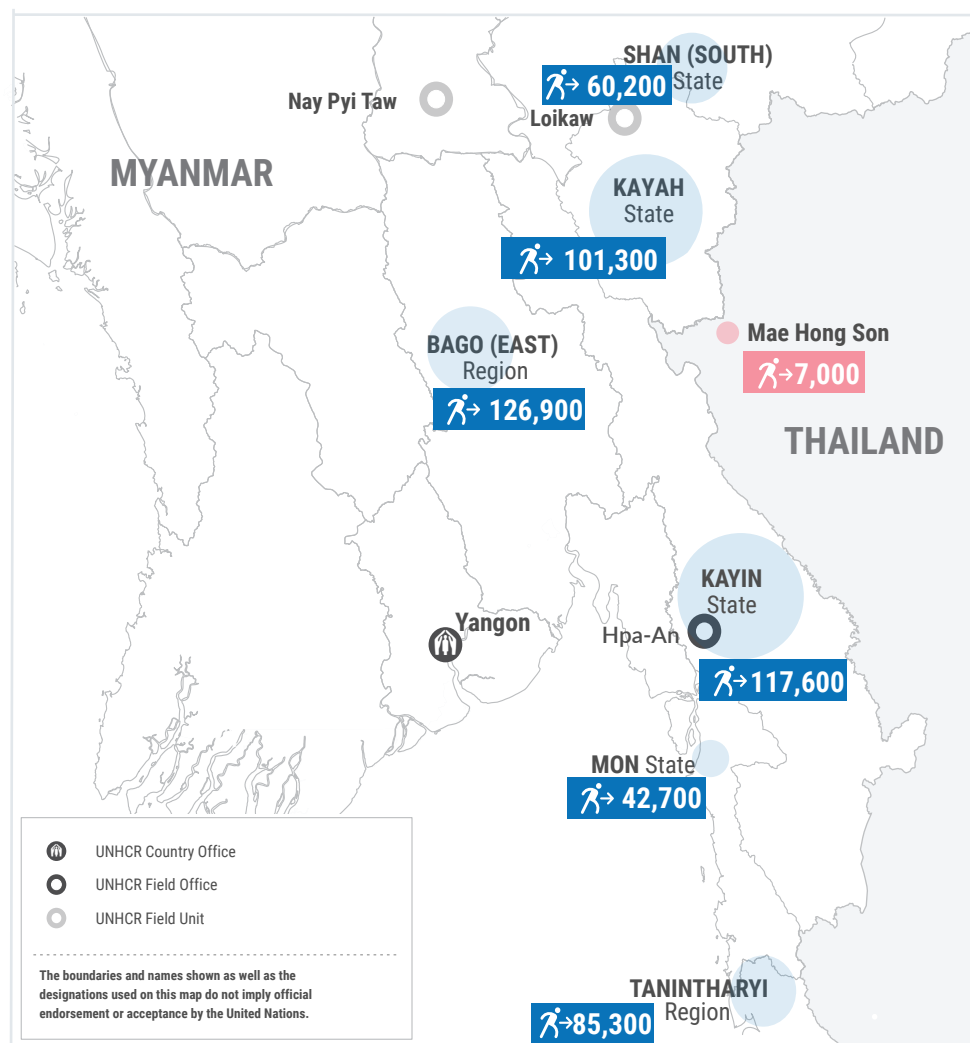
