## **WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS**

In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) slightly increased from 972,200 last week to 972,300 this week.

In Tanintharyi Region, a Tatmadaw's troop reinforcement forced 140 people to flee within Palaw Township, while clashes displaced other 500 from Kye village, also in Palaw Township.

Secondary displacement were registered in Bago Region (East) due to indiscriminate shelling by the Tatmadaw, affecting 213 IDPs in Taungoo Town.

Similarly, in Kayin State, other 62 IDPs had to flee in a secondary displacement as a result of the conflict.
