

Documenting the Victims of November 2014

1-December-2014



The Syrian Human Rights committee documented the killings of 1394 civilians in the month of November in various Syrian provinces. This was due to bombing of explosive barrels, clashes with government forces, snipers, direct field executions by government forces, torture and lack of food and medicine due to the siege.

The number of deaths of children documented by the committee during this month reached 184 children. As well as 110 women, 157 others among them two women killed under torture in government prisons and government security centres.

Twenty- five civilians were killed due to air raids by the International alliance and 73 civilians were killed at the hands of ISIS, in clashes between the organisation and the opposition forces, besides field executions carried out under multiple charges.

Daraa exceeded the rest of the Syrian provinces in terms of the number of victims this month; where the number of victims reached 331 deaths, equivalent to 23.7% of the total victims, followed by the capital Damascus and its suburbs with a total of 281 deaths, equivalent to 20% of the total victims and then Aleppo and its suburbs with 220 deaths.

The total number of deaths in Ar-Raqqah reached 143, 119 in Homs, 110 in Hama and 94 deaths in Idlib.

Moreover the deaths of 82 civilians were documented in Deir Azzour and eight in Al-Hassaka. The deaths of four civilians were also documented in Al-Latakia and two in Al-Quneitra.

It should be noted that Ar-Raqqah witnessed a bloody massacre on 25/11/2014 after a series of air raids by the Syrian Air Force on the city. Activists in the city estimated the deaths between 150-200 victims. However the documentation process is of great difficulty in the city, as ISIS imposes great restrictions on the work of activists, similar to those imposed by the regime in areas controlled by them. Thus activists were only able to document the names of 69 of the victims and they are the names included in this report.
