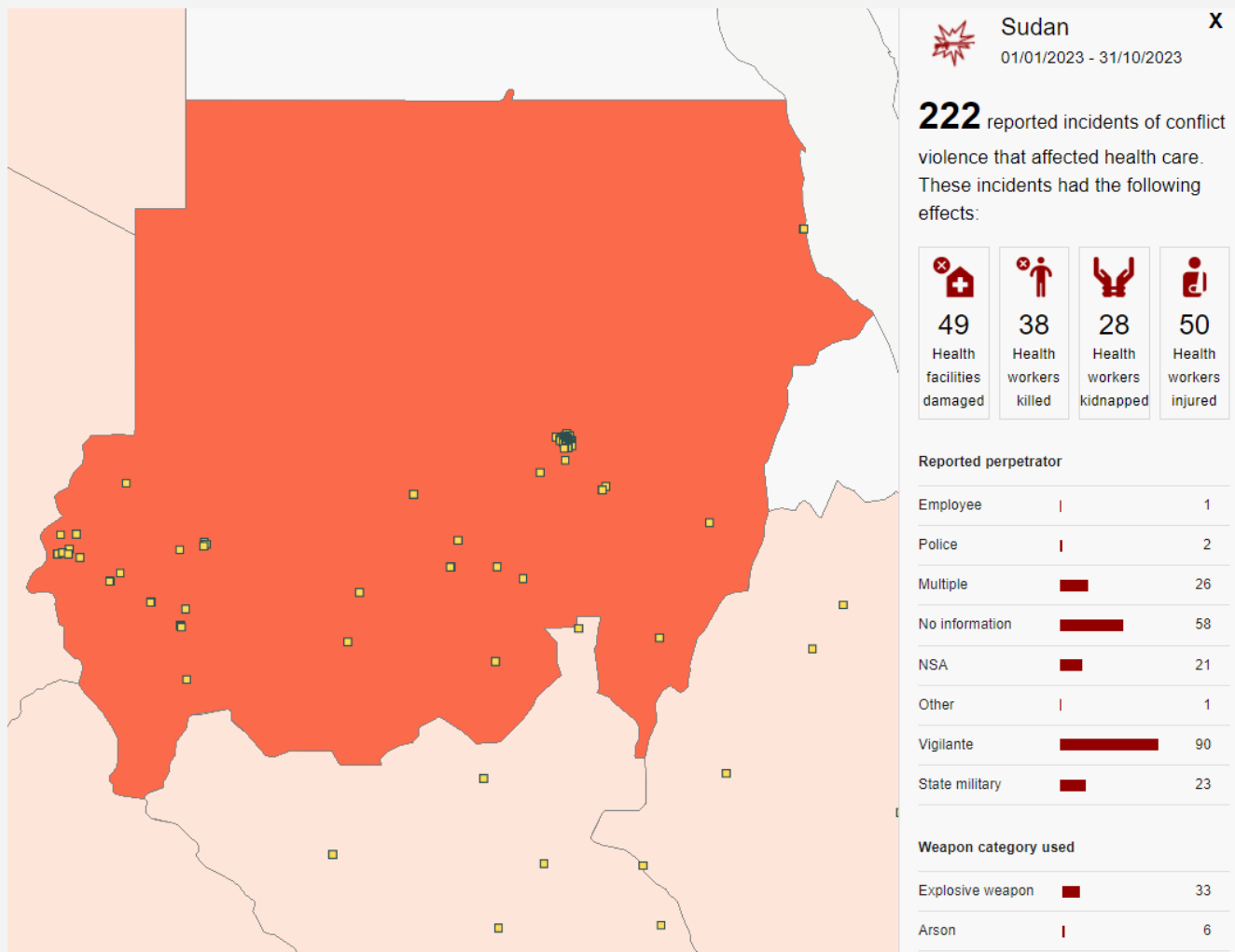

Attacks on Health Care in Sudan

15-28 November 2023



Insecurity Insight has identified at least 222 attacks on Sudan's health care system between 01 January-31 October 2023. In these incidents, 38 health workers have been killed and health facilities have been damaged 49 times. These attacks undermine health care providers' ability to effectively meet patient needs, maintain safe staffing levels and impact the population's access to health care. Documented incidents

18 November 2023: In Babanusa town, West Kordofan state, the director of the pharmacy department at Babanusa Hospital was killed by a stray bullet during fighting. **Source:** [Dabanga Sudan](#)

20 November 2023: In Omdurman, Khartoum State, a nurse at the emergency department at Abu Saad Emergency Hospital was killed by an artillery shell fired by the RSF as he was leaving work. **Sources:** [Personal Communication](#) and [Sudan News](#)

20 November 2023: In Jabal Awliya, Khartoum State, a doctor went missing after he was trapped inside Jabal Awliya Hospital during fighting in the city. **Source:** [Personal Communication](#)

24 November 2023: In El Obeid, North Kordofan State, a female doctor was assaulted by a member of the SAF at the Emergency and Trauma Hospital. In response, the facility temporarily closed. **Source:** [Personal Communication](#)
