

SHRC documents 174 people killed in June

1-JULY-2020 BY SHRC ADMIN



The Syrian Human Rights Committee (SHRC) in Syria has documented the killing of (174) people during the month of June 2020, including (15) children and (4) women, and (90) people who were killed under torture, most of whom were identified through photos that Caesar leaked.

The regime forces were responsible for the killing of (97) people, the Iranian militia was responsible for the killing of (8) people, while the Russian forces were responsible for the killing of (7) people, and the opposition factions – particularly the Al-Sham liberation faction (HTS) – were responsible for the killing of (3) people, And the Kurdish Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) are responsible for killing of (2) persons.

SHRC has documented the death of 25 persons as a result of the explosion of explosive devices and booby traps, 23 people were assassinated by unknown persons, and 3 persons were killed by the explosion of landmines.

The province of Deir ez-Zor topped the rest of the provinces in terms of the number of victims, with a number of them (49), followed by Idlib province with (35) people, and then Daraa Province with (20) people, and Aleppo Province with (16) people.

The total number of victims in each of the provinces of al-Hasakah and al-Raqqa was 13, followed by the provinces of Rif Dimashq and Hama (8) persons, Homs Province with (5) people, Latakia Province with (4) people, and Damascus with (3) people.
