

Syria Situation Report: January 23 - February 6, 2019

5 Jan 23 - 24: IS Likely Expanding Operations in Turkish-Controlled Jan 30: Pro-Opposition Residents Launch Anti-Conscription Campaign in Southern Northern Aleppo Province: The Free Police backed by Turkey detained five alleged Syria: Local residents reportedly affiliated with former opposition groups launched a campaign against conscription by pro-government forces entitled "Do Not Join the Ranks of the Criminal Army" Islamic State (IS) militants in Azaz in Northern Aleppo Province on the Syrian-Turkish Border. Opposition officials claimed that the cell had conducted a series of bombings and in Daraa City in Southern Syria. At least one group of young men bearing arms reportedly marched in the Daraa al-Balad District of Daraa City in a show of strength against the Government of Syria. assassinations in Al-Bab, Jarabulus, and Afrin in Northern Aleppo Province. The group reportedly traveled from Eastern Syria to Northern Aleppo Province around August 2018. Unknown militants previously conducted four bombings in Northern Aleppo Province on January 24.
