
## **WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS**

In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) increased from 912,700 last week to 917,100 this week.

As a result of increased fighting in Shan State (North), 1,256 people from Lashio and Hsipaw Towns were displaced to Taunggyi, Nansang, Laihka, and Mongkaing Townships in Shan State (South).

In Tanintharyi Region, 4,282 people from Thayetchaung and Launglon Townships were newly displaced within the same township due to Tatmadaw troop reinforcement into the villages, while 1,666 people from Thayetchaung Township were displaced as secondary within the same township.

1,225 people returned to their place of origin in Thayetchaung Township.
