WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) increased from 842,100 last week to 899,200 this week.

In Kayah State, due to the fighting, airstrikes, and shelling, 1,000 IDPs from Loikaw Township were displaced to the jungle within the same township. In addition, 2,759 IDPs from Loikaw Township were displaced to Demoso, Hpruso and Loikaw Townships as a secondary displacement.

In Shan State (South), 90 IDPs from Loikaw Township were displaced to Pekon Township while 261 IDPs from Hsihseng Township were displaced to Taunggyi as a secondary displacement due to increased fighting.

In Kayin State, 51,286 IDPs from Myawaddy Town were displaced to near the border and Myawaddy Township due to the intensified fighting, including shelling and airstrike, in the area. Among them, 922 IDPs were displaced as a secondary displacement within Myawaddy Township.

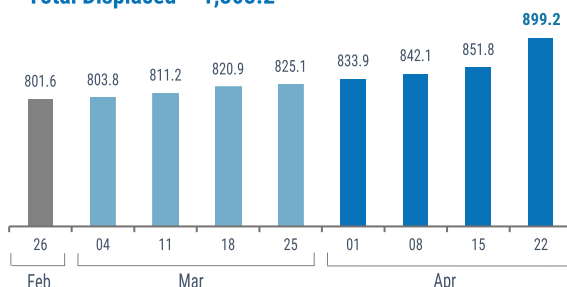
In Tanintharyi Region, 5,700 IDPs from Yebyu Township were displaced within the township due to intensified fighting in the area.

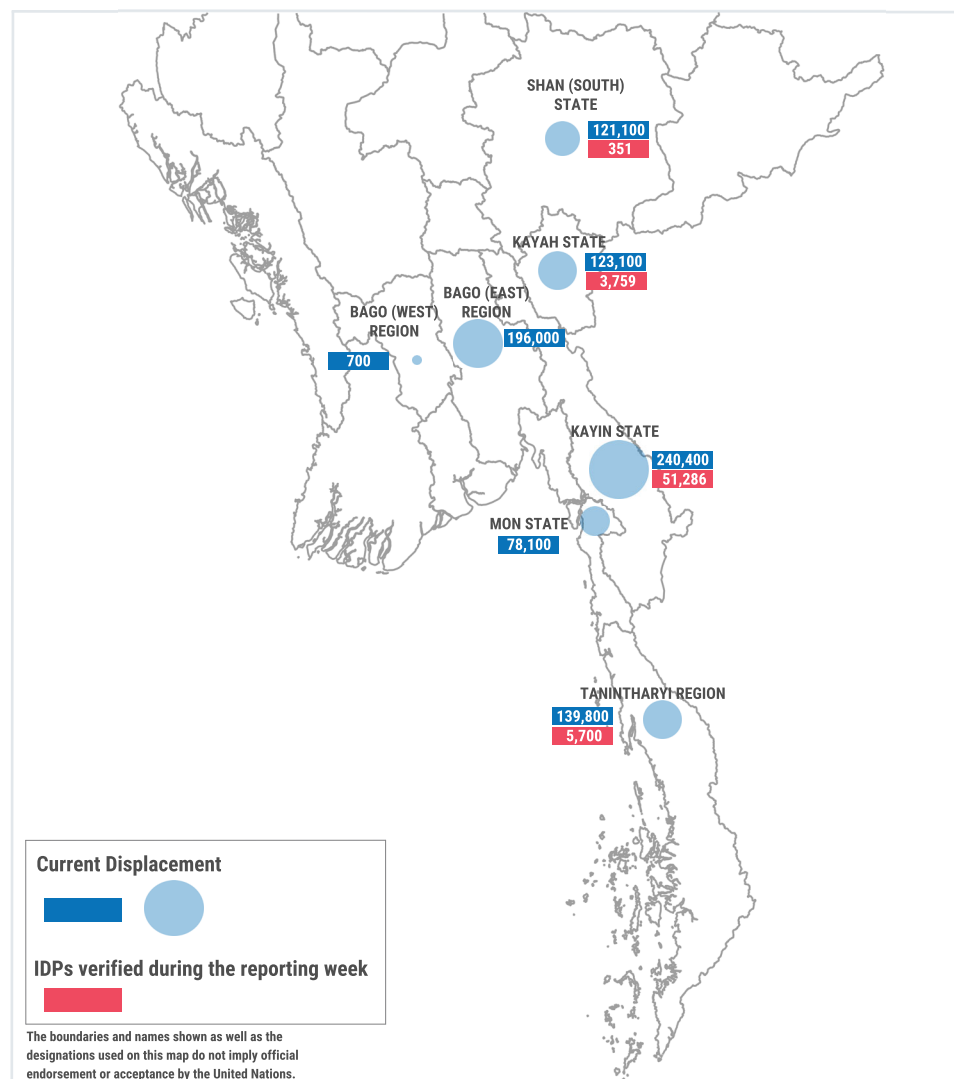

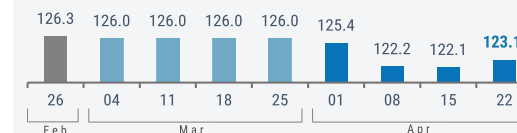

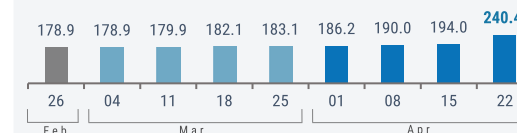
KAYAH STATE

Total Displaced - 227.7



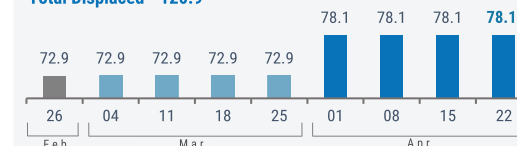
KAYIN STATE

Total Displaced - 307.6



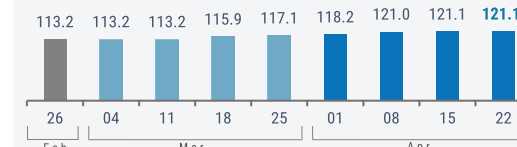
MON STATE

Total Displaced - 120.9



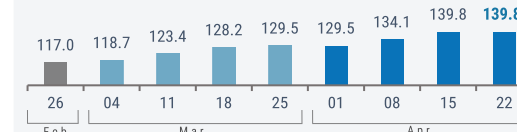
SHAN STATE (South)
