WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of IDPs increased from 510,900 last week to 511,400 this week.

In Kayah State, 1,675 IDPs were verified. 553 IDPs were verified in Hpruso Township, among them 242 IDPs from Hpasawng Township in Kayah State and 311 IDPs from Thandaunggyi Township in Kayin state. In Demoso Township, 50 IDPs were verified, they were displaced from Nganzun Township in Mandala Region. In Loikaw Township, 1,072 IDPs were displaced from Pekon Township in Shan (South) State. The displacements were due to fighting airstrikes and shelling around the region.

In Shan (South), 1,627 IDP individuals who were displaced within Pekon Township, returned to their areas of origin.

In Kayin State, due to the intensified fighting near some villages, 306 IDPs from Myawaddy township were displaced within the township.

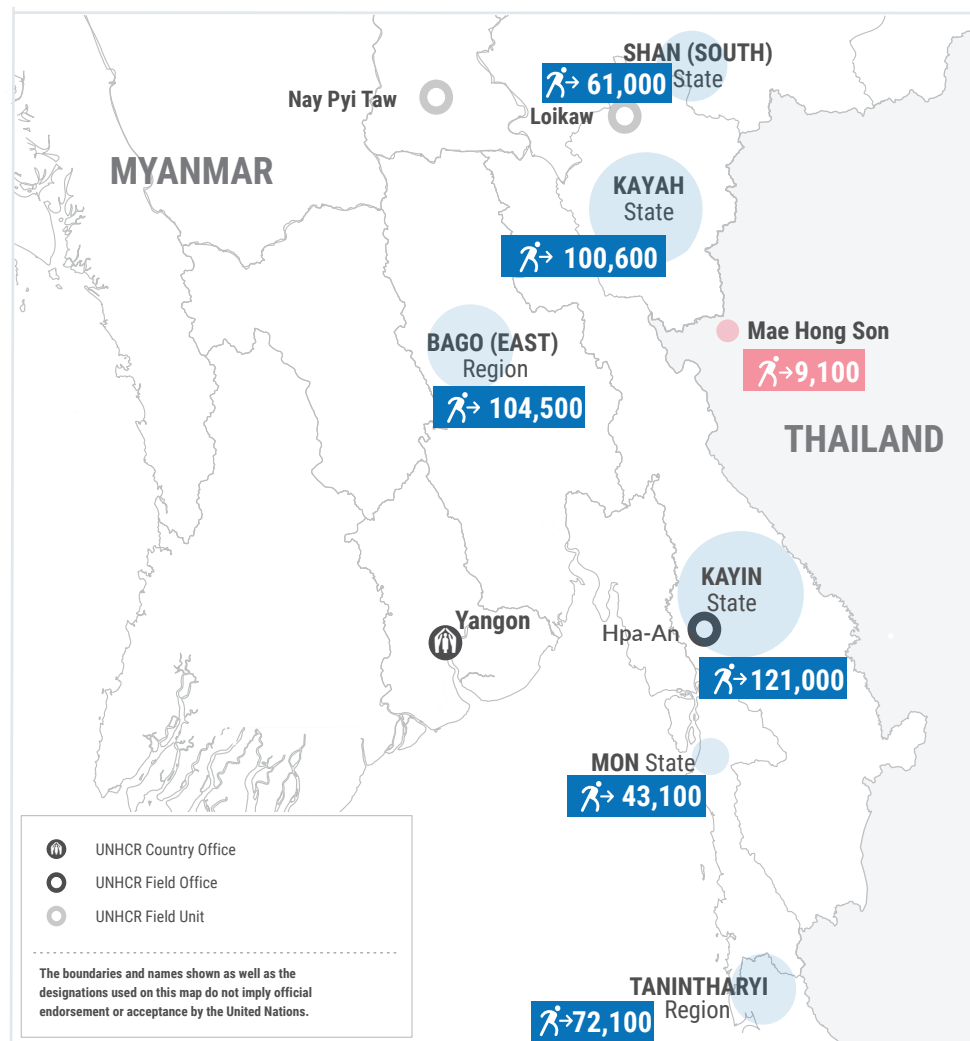
Across the border, 9,060 people from Myanmar remain displaced in Mae Hong Son Province, Thailand.

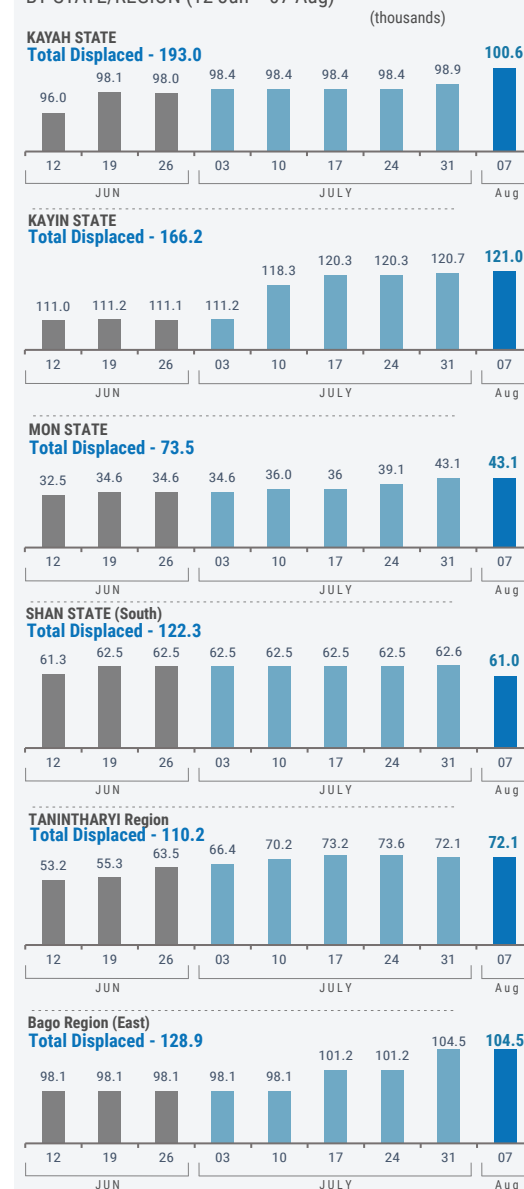

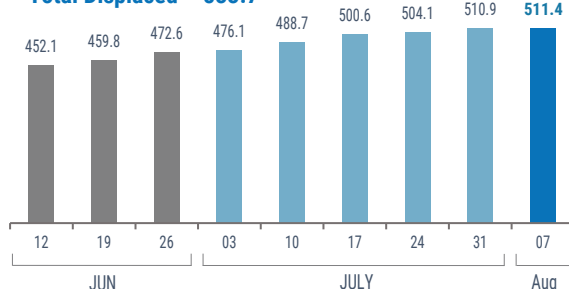
BY STATE/REGION (12 Jun - 07 Aug)
