Monthly Report on Human Rights Violations – April 2024

The Syrian Human Rights Committee (SHRC) documented the killing of (66) civilian individuals in Syria during the month of April 2024, among them were: (13) children, two women, and (5) individuals who died under torture.

The Assad regime was responsible for the killing of (15) individuals, the Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) were responsible for the killing of (12) individuals, and ISIS was responsible for the killing of two individuals.

SHRC documented the killing of (18) individuals due to assassinations by unknown assailants, (12) due to explosions of explosive devices and shelling remnants, and (6) individuals killed due to landmine explosions.

Daraa Governorate topped the other governorates in terms of the number of victims, reaching (28) individuals, followed by Deir ez-Zor Governorate with (12) individuals, and then Aleppo and

Hasakah Governorates with (7) individuals each.

The total number of victims was (4) individuals each in Idlib and Hama Governorates, (2) in Raqqa Governorate, and (1) each in Latakia and Suwayda Governorates.

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
