Daily Report on Violations of Human Rights in Syria: 10/12/2017

10-DECEMBER-2017 BY ADMIN2

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Sunday 10/12/2017 reached 12 deaths. Among the victims was a child.

In Ar-Raqqah, five civilians were killed, three found shot in the head in one of the buildings, and two in a mine explosion remnants of ISIS.

In addition, three died in rural Damascus, two from starvation and the lack of food and medicine due to the siege imposed of eastern Ghouta. A civilian was killed as a result of previous shelling on the town of Madira.

Furthermore, two died in Deir Azzour, one in international alliance shelling on the town of Abu Hamam, and the other shot by ISIS after an argument. An additional two civilians were killed in Idlib for unknown reasons and their bodies were found on the outskirts of the city of Idlib.

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Monday 11/12/2017 reached nine deaths. Among the victims were a child and a woman.

In Deir Azzour, seven civilians were killed, six in shelling on the towns of Abu Hamam and al-Sha'fa, and one shot by a sniper in the town of al-Jarthi.

Furthermore, a civilian was killed as a result of a mine explosion remnant of ISIS. A civilian was also killed in shelling on al-Sad road neighbourhood (Daraa).

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Tuesday 12/12/2017 reached 14 deaths including a child and three women.

In Ar-Raqqah, five civilians were killed, four in a mine explosion remnants of ISIS, and one in a missile explosion remnants of Russian shelling on the village of al-Buhamd.

Furthermore, four died in Deir Azzour as a result of shelling on the towns of al-Gharneej, al-Jarthi and al-Baghuz. A civilian was also killed in a bomb explosion in Mount al-Has (Aleppo).

The killings of three civilians were documented in Damascus, two in shelling on Harasta and Zamlaka, one as a result of the lack of medicine to treat cancer, due to the siege imposed on eastern Ghouta by the regime. The killing of another civilian was documented as a result of shelling on the town of al-Haara (Daraa).

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Wednesday 13/12/2017 reached 30 deaths including two children, a woman, and one killed under torture.

In Deir Azzour, 22 civilians were killed, 20 in international alliance shelling on the town of al-Jarthi, one in artillery shelling on the town of Hajeen, and one shot by Turkish border guards.

In addition, two died in Daraa, one in indiscriminate shelling on the town of Heet, and the other under torture in regime prisons. An additional two civilians were killed in Ar-Raqqah, as a result of mine explosions remnants of ISIS.

The killings of two civilians were documented in Al-Hassaka, one in a mine explosion remnant of ISIS in the town of al-Shamsani, and the other (a baby) refused exit, by the managers of Mabruka camp, for treatment outside the camp. The killings of another two civilians were documented in the town of Bait Sawa (rural Damascus).

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Thursday 14/12/2017 reached 24 deaths including four children and three women.

In Deir Azzour, seven civilians were killed; four in shelling in the town of Hajeen, two in a mine explosion remnants of ISIS in various areas in the province, and one executed at the hands of ISIS.

Furthermore, six were killed in rural Damascus, four in shelling on the town of Bait Jan, Ain Tarma and Zamlaka, one in clashes with government forces, and one due to the lack of food and medicine due to the siege imposed on eastern Ghouta.

In addition, five were killed in Ar-Raqqah, three in international alliance shelling and were found under the rubble, and two in a mine explosion remnant of ISIS. An additional five civilians were killed in Hama in clashes with government forces. The killing of a civilian was documented in Daraa, shot by a regime sniper.

Furthermore, five were killed in Ar-Raqqah, four children as a result of cluster bomb explosion remnants of Russian shelling on the town of Zur Shamr, and one in a mine explosion remnant of ISIS.

In addition, a civilian died in Deir Azzour in shelling in the town of Hajeen, and one in Daraa under torture in a government prison.

In addition, three died in Daraa, two in artillery shelling on the town of Kafr Shams, and one under torture in a regime prison.

Furthermore, three civilians were killed in Ar-Raqqah in a mine explosion remnant of ISIS. An additional three civilians were killed in clashes with government forces in Hama

The killing of a civilian was documented in shelling in the town of Hajeen (Deir Azzour). A civilian was also killed in clashes with government forces in Jabal al-Sheikh (rural Damascus).

The killings of two civilians were documented in Ar-Raqqah, as a result of mine explosions remnants of ISIS. The killings of two civilians were also documented shot by Turkish border guards in Deir Azzour.

Furthermore, five were killed in rural Damascus, three in shelling on Harasta and the town of Ain Tarma, and two in clashes with government forces.

In addition, four died in Deir Azzour, three in shelling on the towns of Hajeen and al-Baghuz, and one under torture in a regime prison.

A further five civilians were killed in Ar-Raqqah, three in a mine explosion remnants of ISIS, and two found under the rubble following previous international alliance shelling.

A civilian was killed as a result of a bomb explosion remnant of shelling in the town of Kafr Hamra (Aleppo). The killing of another civilian was documented in artillery shelling on the town of al-Sa'n (Homs).

In Deir Azzour, nine civilians were killed; six in a car bomb explosion carried out by ISIS at one of Qasd militia barriers in the towns of al-Shaheel, two in shelling in the town of al-Jardi, and one found in the rural school in Mohsin, and it is assumed he was killed at the hands of ISIS before their withdrawal from the city.

Furthermore, three were killed in rural Damascus; one shot by a regime sniper, another as a result of shelling in Harasta, and one in clashes with government forces.

In addition, a civilian was killed in Daraa, shot by Jordanian border guards while attempting to enter Jordanian territory. A baby also died in Yarmouk camp (Al-Hassaka) as a result of the lack of medicine.

In addition, two died in Ar-Raqqah in a mine explosion remnant of ISIS. An additional two civilian were killed in a bomb explosion remnant of shelling on the town of Khan al-Asal (Aleppo).

The killing of a civilian was documented in shelling on the town of al-Latamina, and another civilian from Daraa under torture in a regime prison.

Furthermore, eight were killed in Hama, four in shelling on the towns of al-Latamina and Kafr Zeita, and four in clashes with government forces.

In addition, three died in Deir Azzour, two in shelling on the town of al-Sawsa, and one from wounds sustained in a car bomb explosion in the town of al-Shaheel days ago. A civilian was also killed in mine explosion remnants of ISIS in Ar-Raqqah.

The killings of two civilians were documented in rural Damascus in clashes with the regime, and another in shelling on Jobar neighbourhood (Southern Damascus). In addition, a civilian was killed as a result of a mine explosion remnant of ISIS in the village of al-Mastuha (Aleppo).

The killings of two civilians were documented as a result of clashes with government forces in Hama. The killings of another two civilians were documented in rural Damascus, one in clashes with the regime and the other shot by a regime sniper.

Furthermore, six were killed in Ar-Raqqah as a result of a mine explosion remnant of ISIS.

In addition, two died in Homs, one in clashes with government forces and the other in shelling on the town of Taldu. A civilian was killed in rural Damascus, in shelling on the road between the town of al-Rayhan and Douma.

In Rif Dimashq province ten people were killed: Seven due to the bombing of both Hamouriya and Harasta cities, two due to clashes with regime forces, and one as a result of a lack of medication and nutrition caused by the imposed siege on Eastern Ghouta.

Four people were killed in Idlib province due to the bombing of Maarrat al-Nouman city and Al-Tah town, whilst three were killed in Al-Hasakah province due to airstrikes by the Global Coalition air force on Tal Al-Dahab village targeting an ISIS base.

In addition, two victims were documented in Deir ez-Zor province, one due to bombing by the Global Coalition on Al-Bahra town, and another after a land mine from the remnants of ISIS exploded in Darnaj town. Furthermore, another victim was documented after a land mine from the remnants of ISIS exploded in Ar-Raqqah province.

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Saturday 30/12/2017 reached 35 deaths including six children and two women.

Twenty-six people were killed in Rif Dimashq province: 19 due to the bombing of the cities and towns of Eastern Ghouta (including 13 victims in Harasta alone), six due to clashes with regime forces, and one due to the lack of medical equipment and medication caused by the siege.

Five people were killed in Daraa province including four in an IED explosion on the road connecting the towns of Rakhm and Al-Karak al-Sharqi, and one due to arbitrary shooting on the outskirts of Dael city.

Two were killed in Deir ez-Zor province, one due to artillery shelling of Al-Susu town, whilst the other was executed by regime forces in Al-Bukamal.

In addition, one person was killed after the explosion of a land mine from the remnants of ISIS in Ar-Raqqah province, and another was killed in clashes with regime forces in Hama province.

Twelve people were killed in Deir ez-Zor province due to Global Coalition air strikes on Al-Susah town in rural Al-Bukamal.

Eight people were killed in Rif Dimashq province including five due to bombing in Madira town and Arbin and Douma cities, and three in clashes with regime forces.

Additionally, two were killed when a land mine from the remnants of ISIS exploded in Ar-Raqqah province.

Four people were killed in Deir ez-Zor province including two in a land mine explosion from the remnants of ISIS, one who was shot by Syria Democratic Forces (SDF) militia in Abu Hardub town, and a woman that was executed by ISIS on charges of 'insulting the divine'.

Six were killed in Rif Dimashq province when Otaya town and Arbin, Douma and Harasta cities were bombed. One was also killed in the bombing of Al-Maziyyah town in Idlib province.

SHRC also documented the death of two people in Homs province, one shot by a regime force sniper and the other during an artillery shelling of the outskirts of Talbiseh city.

Eight people were killed in Idlib province: Seven due to multiple air raids on Khan Al-Subul town, and one due to Russian airstrikes on Awram al-Juz town.

One person was killed in Homs province due to artillery shelling to neighbourhoods of Al-Ghanto town. Another person was killed in Ar-Raqqah province after a landmine from the remains of ISIS exploded in the city.

SHRC also documented the death of a woman in Al-Hasakah province after she was shot by the Iraqi militia 'Popular Mobilisation Forces' (PMF) whilst trying to cross into Northern Iraq.

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Wednesday 03/01/2018 reached 47 deaths including nine children and 18 women.

In Rif Dimashq province, 32 people were killed after the towns and cities of Eastern Ghouta were bombed: Twenty due to Russian bombing of Misraba town, eight in Arbin city, three in Bait Sawa, and one in Harasta city.

Nine people were killed in Idlib province: Five due to bombing of Tal Touqan town, two due to bombing on Maarrat Al-Nouman city, and two who were assassinated by unknown perpetrators in Al-Magharah town.

Five people were killed in Ar-Raqqah province including: Three children from the cold in 'Rajm Al-Abyad' refugee camp, one who was shot by the 'Syria Democratic Forces' (SDF) Militia whilst working on his land, one who was killed after a landmine from the remnants of ISIS exploded. One person was also killed due to a landmine explosion in Mehaimda village in Deir ez-Zor province.

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Friday 05/01/2018 reached 14 deaths including five children and two women.

In Idlib province, five people were killed due to bombing of the towns Badama and Al-Ghadfah, and Al-Saqiyah and Al-Maliha villages.

Four people were killed in Deir ez-Zor province, including three in a landmine explosion (remnants of ISIS) in Al-Basirah town, and one due to a hand grenade that was dropped in a dispute between armed members of the National Defence.

Four deaths were documented in Ar-Raqqah province after land mines from the remnants of ISIS exploded, and one person was shot by a regime sniper in Homs Province.

Five people were killed in Idlib province including four that were killed by bombing of Kafr Nabl city and Ejaz and Kafarya villages, and a displaced person from Sinjar town died due to extreme cold.

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Sunday 07/01/2018 reached 57 deaths including nine children and 16 women.

In Idlib province, 45 people were killed due to bombing including: 25 in bombing of 'Thalatheen' street in Idlib city, 12 in 'Al-Fa'lul' farm and eight in Al-Ghadfah, Kansafra and Kafr Nabl.

Eight people were killed in Rif Dimashq province due to bombing of Arbin and Hamouriya cities. Additionally, three were killed in Ar-Raqqah province including two who were confirmed dead due to earlier air raids by the Global Coalition on Ar-Raqqah city, and one who died after a land mine from the remnants of ISIS exploded.

In Ar-Rastan city in Homs province, one person died after being shot by regime snipers.

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Monday 08/01/2018 reached 48 deaths including 16 children and six women.

In Rif Dimashq province, 27 people were killed due to bombings of the cities and towns of Eastern Ghouta. They were distributed as follows: 13 in Douma city, five in Madira, four in Saqba, three in Arbin and one in each of Hamouriya and Otaya.

In Idlib province, 11 people were killed including: Five who were removed from below the rubble after 'Thalatheen' neighbourhood was bombed in Idlib city yesterday (Sunday 07/01/2018), five due to bombings of Saraqeb and Kanasfra, and one who was shot by the Turkish border guards as he was trying to cross.

Three people were killed in Homs province as Al-Farhaniya village and Al-Ghanto town were bombed. Additionally, one person was assassinated in Daraa province by unknown perpetrators.

Four deaths were documented in Deir ez-Zor province, including three in a landmine explosion from the remnants of ISIS, and one due to a warplane raid that targeted his car during the offensive on Al-Jerthi town. Additionally, two deaths were documented after a landmine from the remnants of ISIS exploded in Ar-Raqqah province.

The total number of victims (which we were able to document) in Syria on Tuesday 09/01/2018 reached 42 deaths including 13 children and eight women.

In Rif Dimashq province, 26 people were killed due to bombings of the cities and towns of Eastern Ghouta. They were distributed as follows: 13 in Hamouriya town, seven in Douma city, two in Harasta city, three in Saqba city, and one in Madira town.

In Idlib province, 9 people were killed including eight during a bombing of Abu Al-Duhur town and one during a bombing of Al-Habeet town.

Three people were killed in Aleppo, due to Russian bombing on Jazraya town. Additionally, two people were killed in Aleppo province after the towns of Kafr Laha and Talbiseh were bombed.

One death was documented in Deir ez-Zor province after a land mine from the remnants of ISIS exploded. Finally, one person was killed when Jobar neighbourhood was bombed, South of the capital Damascus.

In Rif Dimashq province, 15 people were killed: 13 in the 09/01/2018 bombings of Hamouriya town, two in bombings of Arbin city, and one in bombings of Madira town.

Ten people were killed in Idlib province: Five in a car bomb explosion in Idlib city, three in bombings of Maarrat Al-Nouman, and two in bombings of Sarageb city.

One person was killed in Deir ez-Zor province after a land mine from the remnants of ISIS exploded in Al-Keshkiya town. Additionally, a child in Al-Hasakah province was found dead on the Khabur river bank with evidence of torture on his body.

Five people were killed in Deir ez-Zor province: Two were executed by ISIS, one died in a land mine explosion in Abu Al-Hamam town, one was killed by a sniper while shepherding his sheep in Hajeen town, and one who died under torture in one of the regime's prisons.

In Ar-Raqqah province, four people were killed including: Three whose bodies were found under the rubble after previous raids by the Global Coalition air force on Ar-Raqqah city, and two in a land mine explosion from the remnants of ISIS.

Five people were killed in Idlib province, including: Four after bombings of Maarrat Al-Nouman, Khan Shaykhun and Saraqeb, and one whose body was found near the Syrian-Turkish borders. Moreover, five people were killed after bombings of the cities and towns of Eastern Ghouta, in Rif Dimashq province. Additionally, one death was documented after bombings of Al-Saan Al-Aswad town in Homs province.

The death toll of victims SHRC documented in Syria on Friday, 12-1-2018, is 20 civilians including: (3) children and a woman.

In Rif Dimashq, 10 people were killed, 9 of them in the bombing of the eastern towns and villages of Eastern Ghouta, 5 in Hamouriyah, 2 in Harasta and 1 in Douma and Arbeen. In addition to one who was shot by stray bullets on the road of Arbeen.

In the province of Idlib (6) people were killed, including 5 due to bombing of the towns of Altmanah and the town of Abu-Habah, and (1) the fall of projectiles on the camp Hamoudin addition to (4) civilians in the province of Deir ez-Zor were executed by ISIL.

The Syrian Human Rights Committee documented the names of the following 16 victims:

The death toll of victims documented by SHRC in Syria on Saturday 13-1-2018, was 28 civilians including 7 children and 9 women.

In the province of Idlib (16) people were killed, including (14) due to the shelling of the towns of Khan al-Subul, Sarjah and Kafr-Batich, and (2) after an explosion in the city of Idlib.

In Deir ez-Zor province, 4 persons were killed, including (1) was killed by ISIL after his arrest for almost 45 days, (1) was executed four months ago by the regime forces in al-Hamidiya neighbourhood and his body was found today, (1) killed by a Kurdish SDF sniper in Jazrat Albu-Hmeid, and (1) due to shelling the town of Soussa.

Five were also killed in Rif Dimashq following the bombing of Douma and Arbin. Two also were killed in the province of Homs due to the shelling of the town of Ghanto.

One civilian was also killed by random shooting of armed factions in the village of Al-Bakkar in the province of Daraa.

The total number of victims we were able to document in Syria on Tuesday 16-1-2018, was 16 including (7) children and (3) women.

In Idlib province, 14 civilians were killed including (11) by the shelling the towns of Maara-Shmarin, Tbiesh and Ankarati, (2) were assassinated on the Ma'arat- Misrin road, and (1) by remaining of cluster bomb explosion in the town of Mar'ayan.

In Daraa province (5) civilians were killed (3) by the bombing of Alujat area and (2) by an explosive device while dismantling on the road between the villages of Sh'ara and Karm Al-Janoubi.

In Rif Dimashq province (4) civilians were killed due to the bombing of Douma.

In addition, 4 civilians were killed in Aleppo province, 3 of them due to the shelling of Irenaz village and 1 by an explosive device planted in an agricultural tractor in the city of Grapes.

Death Toll

The total number of victims documented by SHRC in Syria was 10 on Friday 19/1/2018, including 3 children and 1 died under torture.

In the province of Idlib, 4 civilians were killed by the Russian aircrafts bombing of Sarqeb, and Mara'ar-hatat in Idlib southern countryside.

In the capital, Damascus, 2 were killed, one of them in the bombing of the Jober neighbourhood whilst the other under torture in the regime's forces prison. A third one died due to the shortage of medicine caused by the siege of the eastern Ghouta in Rif Dimashq (Damascus countryside).

SHRC also documented the killing of a civilian by the bombing of Kurdish militias of al-Bab in the province of Aleppo. In addition, two civilians were killed in the explosion of landmines left by ISIS; one in Raqqa province and the other in the town of Husseiniya in Deir al-Zour province.

The total number of victims documented by SHRC in Syria was 19 on Saturday, 20-1-2018, including two children and two women.

In Rif Dimashq (Damascus countryside), 14 civilians were killed in the bombing of the eastern towns and villages of Al-Ghouta. They were distributed as follows: 9 people in Douma, 4 in Hamouriya and 1 in Hazrama, Arbin and Zamalka.

Two were killed in Idlib province, one of the bombing of Lawf, and the other due to an explosive device. Two were killed also in Deir ez-Zor province due to an explosion of landmines left by ISIS. One civilian was killed in Latamnah in Hama Province because of bombing of the town.

In the province of Aleppo (7) people were killed due to the Turkish aerial bombardment on the area of Mo'ambatli (Mobato) in the countryside of Afrin.

In the province of Idlib (2) were killed due to the Russian shelling of vacuum rockets on al-Kana'is village in Ma'arat al-Nu'man countryside.

One civilian was killed due to the shelling of Douma in Rif Dimashq. And one was killed due to an explosion of a landmine from the remnants of ISIS
