"Syria Response Coordinators" team reports on the situation of Syrian northwest

The Syria Response Coordinators team released a statistic documenting the humanitarian situation in north western Syria between November 2019 and March 8, as the region was subjected to violent military attacks by Assad's forces, supporting militia and major backing by Russian warplanes.

The team documented the killing of 701 civilians due to Assad militia and Russian warplanes attacks, including 381 men, 91 women, 212 children and 17 humanitarian workers.

The statistic recorded the targeting of 225 vital facilities, including 20 sheltering centres, 88 educational facilities, 32 health facilities, 8 ambulances, 9 civil defence centers, 14 bakeries, 31 places of worship, and 23 other vital and service facilities, such as water, electricity and other stations by the Assad regime and Russian warplanes.

The number of IDPs during the fighting reached 1,041,233 civilians distributed over 185,672 families, of whom 632,453 civilians were displaced from the countryside of Idlib province, and 408,780 civilians were displaced from the rural areas of Aleppo province.
