

Flygtningenævnets baggrundsmateriale

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The Syrian Human Rights Committee (SHRC) documented the death of 264 people in Syria in February 2019. Of whom: 85 were children, 34 were women and 33 were killed under torture.

The regime's forces were responsible for the death of 134 people, the Kurdish People's Protection Forces were responsible for the killing of 11 people and ISIS was responsible for the death of 16 people; while the Turkish gendarme killed 5 people, the opposition factions killed 4 people, and the International Coalition Forces killed 2.

The total number of victims killed by mines reached 51 and the number of people killed by IEDs reached 37, 17 people were killed by unknown persons and 3 died of lack of medical care in the two camps of al-Hawl and Soor.

The province of Idlib, was in the forefront in the number of victims, which reached (95) people, followed by the province of Hama (49) people, then the province of Deir ez-Zor (48) people, and then the province of Aleppo (34) people.

The total number of victims in Homs province reached 18 persons, 6 persons in ar-Raqqa province, 5 in Rif Dimashq province, 4 in al-Hasakeh province, 3 in Daraa gprovince, 2 in Latakia province.
