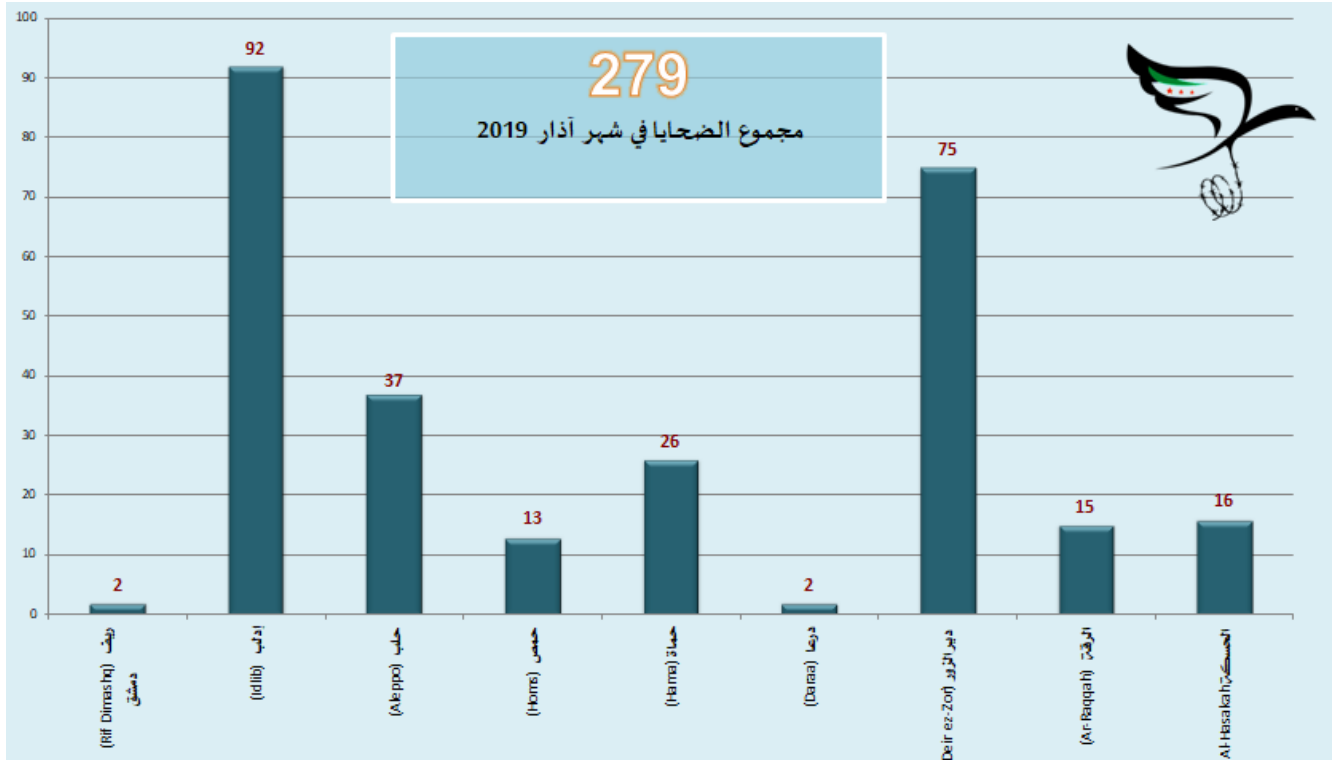

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SHRC documents the death of 279 people in March

The Syrian Human Rights Committee documented the death of 279 people in Syria during March 2019, of whom 73 children, 55 women and 28 people who were killed under torture.

The regime's forces were responsible for the killing of 79 people, the Russian air force was responsible for the killing of 41 people and ISIS was responsible for the killing of 31 people. The international coalition (Global Alliance) killed 8 people, the Kurdish militia killed 16, Sham Liberation killed two people.

The total number of victims killed by landmines was 56, and the number of people killed by IEDs was 16. SHRC documented the death of 22 people by unknown assailants and 11 people died as a result of the lack of medical and healthcare care in the camps of al-Houl in al-Hasakeh and al-Rukban on the Syrian-Jordanian borders.

The province of Idlib came in the forefront in terms of the number of victims, where it reached (92) people, followed by the province of Deir ez-Zor (75) people, and then the province of Aleppo (37) people.

The total number of victims in Hama province reached 26, 16 in al-Hasakeh, 15 in al-Raqqa, 13 in Homs, 2 in each of Rif Dimashq and Daraa provinces, and 1 in the province of Latakia.
