WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

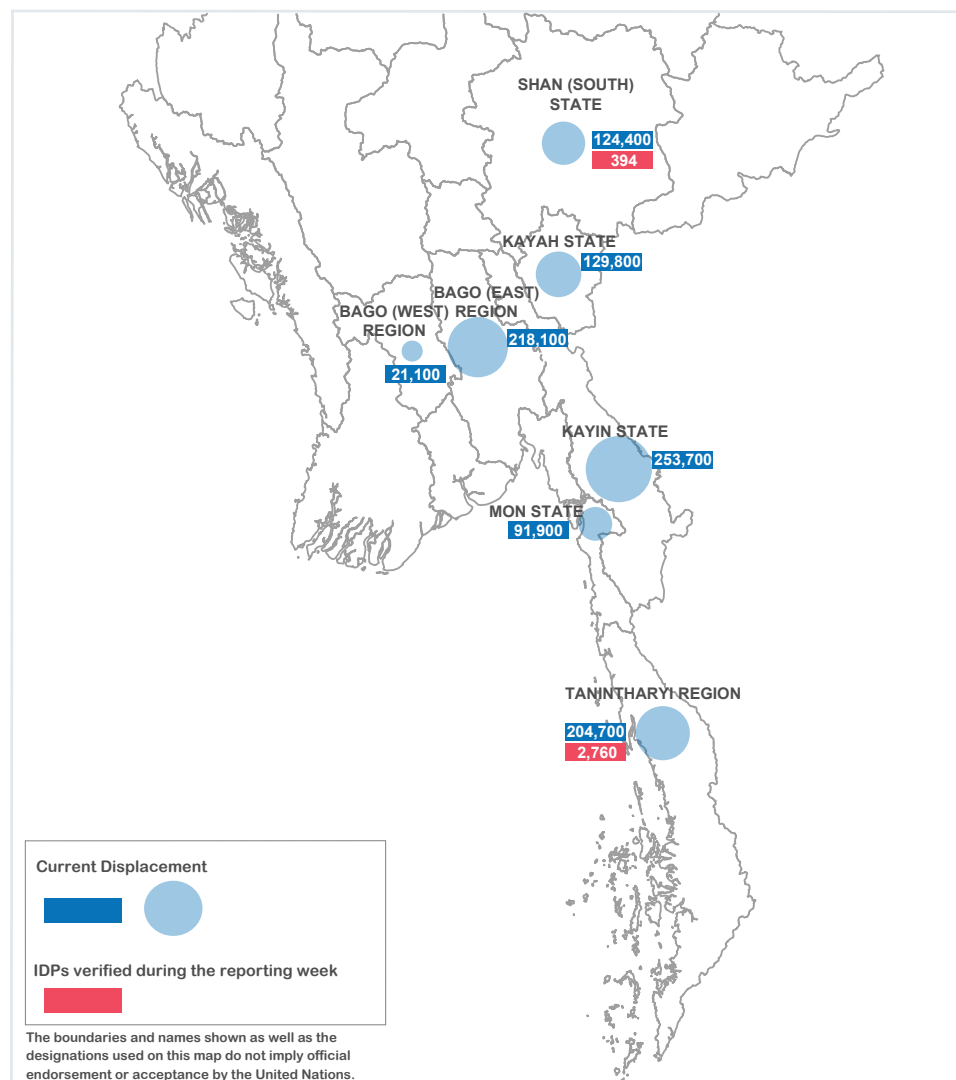
In the South-East, the number of IDPs increased from 1,041,300 last week to 1,043,700 this week.

New displacements were reported in Shan State (South), where 77 individuals from Pinlaung, 195 from Pekon, and 122 from Nyaungshwe Township were newly displaced within the same townships due to armed clashes and shelling. Meanwhile, 87 IDPs from Lawksawk Township reportedly returned to their place of origin in Lashio Township.

In Kayah State, 50 IDPs from Demoso Township reportedly returned to their place of origin within the same township.

In Tanintharyi Region, 2,760 people from Launglon Town have been displaced within the same township due to shelling.

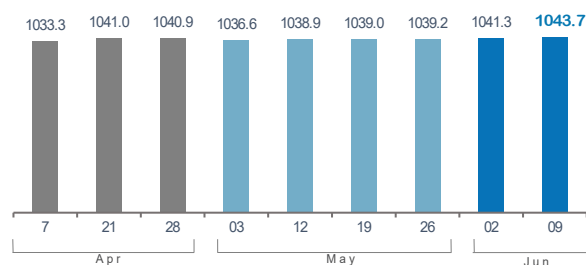
